Audio Conferencing Service

Effective March 9, 1998, Audio Conference Service will no longer be offered. Existing customers under (T) contract may retain the use of this service.

Audio Conference Service provides for the interconnection of two or more participants via an audio (T) conference bridge such that all participants may communicate with each other. Participants are connected to audio conference bridge ports via dial-in (meet-me) service, dial-in 800 service or dial-out service.

- A. Standard Features
 - Meet-Me Service -- Each participant dials in to a preassigned direct-dial telephone number and is connected to an audio conference bridge port automatically or by an audio conference operator. Each participant incurs his or her own long distance charges to reach the audio conference bridge. Conferencing charges are billed to the conference chairperson or a designated billing location.
 - 2. Meet-Me 800 Service -- Each participant dials in to a preassigned 800 number and is connected to an audio conference bridge port automatically or by an audio conference operator. Long distance 800 charges and conferencing charges are billed to the conference chairperson or a designated billing location.
 - 3. Dial-Out Service -- An audio conference operator will dial-out to each participant and connect each to a port in the audio conference bridge. The conference chairperson designates the interexchange carrier to be used for all interLATA calls. Long distance charges and conferencing charges are billed to the conference chairperson or a designated billing location.

- B. Optional Features
 - 1. Polling Allows participants to respond to questions by pressing a designated button on the telephone keypad.
 - 2. Question and Answer Capability By pressing a designated button on the telephone keypad to be recognized, allows a participant to interact with the chairperson on an individual basis.
 - 3. Subconferencing Enables a subgroup to have its own audio conference during a large audio conference.
 - 4. Electronic Roll Call Allows chairperson to take attendance using the telephone keypad.
