A1. DEFINITION OF TERMS

TRUNK ANSWERING ANY STATION

Incoming calls, normally directed to the attendant, activate a common alerting signal on the customer's premises when the attendant positions are in night service and night stations are not assigned or are all busy. These calls may then be answered by any station user in the system who dials a special code from any nonrestricted station.

TRUNK GROUP BUSY INDICATION ON ATTENDANT POSITION

Provides the attendant with a visual indication when all trunks in a group are busy.

TRUNK GROUP WARNING INDICATION ON ATTENDANT POSITION

Provides the attendant with a visual indication when a present number of trunks in a group are busy.

TRUNK TO TRUNK CONNECTIONS

This feature allows an incoming or outgoing trunk call to be extended to another outgoing trunk. Trunk to trunk connections can be effected among the following types of trunks: C.O., FX, WATS, CCSA Network, and Tie Trunks.

All combinations of these trunk connections can be effected by the attendant. In addition, Tie Trunk to CCSA Network (cut through) and Tie Trunk to C.O. (or FX or WATS) may be dialed directly by a station user. Disconnect supervision can be automatic in some cases, but in others the attendant must monitor the connection and manually disconnect after use.

TRUNK VERIFICATION BY CUSTOMER

Provides the attendant access to individual trunks of a group to verify supervision and transmission.

TWO-TIER PAYMENT PLAN

An optional payment plan available for certain selected services in which the monthly charges are divided into two pricing elements. The first element, called Tier A, is applicable for a specified period of time, selected by the customer from the options in the guidebook and is not subject to Company-initiated changes. The second elements, called Tier B, is applicable for as long as the customer keeps the service and is subject to Company-initiated rate changes.

USOC (Uniform Service Order Code)

A Company-assigned code used on internal records for service identification purposes.

VACANT CODE RECORDING

A central office standard prerecorded voice announcement received by callers when a restricted or invalid code is dialed.

VINTAGE PRICING

A form of guidebook pricing under which rates for all or parts of existing installations are held at present rate levels and a new guidebook based on the then current conditions is filed.

VRMS (Volts Root-Mean-Square)

The effective value of AC voltage.

A3.30 Exchange Access Premium Charge

A3.30.1 General

- A. A premium charge will apply to any exchange service customer, other than a residence customer, who subscribes to certain features typically associated with high network usage.
- B. The premium charge applies on a monthly basis in addition to rates and charges for flat, message or measured exchange service.
- C. The premium charge applies to each exchange service access facility associated with any of the following features:
 - 1. **(DELETED)**
 - 2. Multiline Hunt Queuing
 - 3. Simplified Message Desk Interface (SMDI)
 - 4. Surrogate Client Number (SCN)
- D. For purposes of this offering, premium features, premium lines and non-premium lines are defined as follows:
 - 1. A premium feature is any feature listed in C. preceding. Rates and charges for stand-alone premium features are as specified in Section A13. Rates and charges for the ESSX service or Digital ESSX service SMDI premium feature are as specified in Section A12.
 - 2. A premium line is any non-residence exchange service access facility associated with a premium feature. A premium line includes but is not limited to the following types of exchange service access facilities associated with a premium feature:
 - a. Exchange service business individual lines, trunks or PBX trunks.
 - b. ESSX service Network Access Registers (NARs) or MegaLink channel service Network Access Service (NAS).
 - c. Foreign central office or foreign exchange lines contained in Section A9.
 - d. Dial access channels contained in A29.2.
 - e. Voice grade channels and DS0 channel services used by any Mobile or Radio Common Carrier to interconnect with the exchange network.
 - f. Announcement lines used by Public Announcement Services as defined in A13.10.
 - g. Exchange lines used in the provisioning of Public Telephone Access service for Customer Provided Equipment (CPE) as defined in A7.4.
 - h. Trunk Side Access Facilities specified in A3.28.
 - 3. A non-premium line is any exchange service access facility not associated with a premium feature.

A3.30.2 Terms and Conditions

- A. Premium charges apply only with respect to premium lines.
- B. A premium charge applies per premium line. When more than one premium feature is selected by the customer, only one premium charge per line will apply.
- C. A combination of premium and non-premium lines will be allowed in the same premises to the same subscriber. However, premium and non-premium lines in the same subscriber premises must be separated in different hunting groups.
- D. Service charges normally associated with the exchange access facility, as specified in A4 will apply.
- E. The terms and conditions specified herein are in addition to the applicable terms and conditions specified in other sections of this and other guidebooks of the Company.

A13.30.1 General

- A. Automatic Time and Charge Reporting Service is available to subscribers requiring billing information on messages routed through Traffic Service Position System (T.S.P.S.) facilities and charged to the originating station.
- B. A teleprinter print-out of the time and charges may be provided as part of this service. The service may be provided with or without the teleprinter at the customer's option at the rates shown following. In either case, the appropriate channel termination will be provided by the Company to terminate the line from the T.S.P.S. trunk termination point.
- C. The Company reserves the right to deny this service based on a small volume of quoted messages per month and/or distance from the T.S.P.S. trunk termination point.

- A. Channels Between Buildings on the Same Premises
(Obsoleted 01-01-81, Type D; not available for new installations, moves or transfers. Existing customers may add channels only to the extent that they are available, Reference Section A13.)

These channels are provided to extend exchange or ESSX-1 service terminated in a Company-provided, or a customer-provided non-button telephone to another building on the same premises or to extend Company-provided or customer-provided communications systems such as PBX or Key Systems to other buildings on the same premises.

When the customer provides his own communication system, such as PBX or Key System, the customer may provide the facilities required to extend the use of his system from one building to another on the same premises.

When all terminations are located on the same premises a mileage charge applies for the direct airline distance between buildings, determined in one-tenth mile increments (a fractional one-tenth mile being considered as a full one-tenth mile).

Where a supporting structure is necessary for the purpose of furnishing extension lines on the subscriber's premises such structures shall be furnished by the subscriber as provided for in "Construction on Private Property" in Section A5.
