<b>Descriptive Narrative:</b>	<p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&amp;T Alabama intends to retire copper facilities serving distribution areas (DA), identified in the impacted address attachment, in the following wire centers: Alexander City (ALCYALMT), Albertville (ALVLALMA), Athens (ATHNALMA), Auburn (AUBNALMA), Cahaba Heights (BRHMALCH), Bucksville (BSMRALBU), Bessemer (BSMRALMA), Calera (CALRALMA), Chelsea (CHLSALMA), Eufala (EUFLALMA), Hillside (GDSDALHS), Gardendale (GRDLALNM), Gurley (GRLYALMA), Hartselle (HRTSALNM), Dalraida (MTGMALDA), Millbrook (MTGMALMB), Opelika (OPLKALMT), and Prattville (PRVLALMA). No customers are currently served by these copper facilities, so this action will have no impact on customers.</p> <p>AT&amp;T Alabama plans to continue providing service to these DAs over existing Gigabit Passive Optical Network/Fiber-to-the-Premises (GPON/FTTP) and retire the copper facilities.</p> <p>After implementation of the planned changes, only fiber-based services will be available in these DAs. AT&amp;T Alabama records indicate there are no working circuits, including competitive carrier circuits, on the copper facilities in these DAs.</p>
