This filing revises Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A5. Exchange Services, 5.10 Exchange Boundary Maps, to realign the boundaries for AT&T California's Encinitas, Rancho Bernardo, Rancho Penasquitos, Rancho Santa Fe and San Marcos Exchanges. These proposed changes are so that various subdivisions under development will be located in their entirety in the Exchange that that would be the most cost effective to both future customers and AT&T California (see attachments). There are no customers affected by this realignment.
