We attach for filing this Tier I advice letter to make the following changes in tariff sheets:

This filing revises Schedule Cal.P.U.C. No. 175-T Access Service, Section 5. Ordering Options and Section 6. Switched Access Service, to withdraw Operator Transfer Service (OTS).

OTS is a service that allows an AT&T incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC) operator to transfer a caller, who dials zero and wishes to place an interLATA call, to a participating interexchange carrier (IXC). To subscribe to OTS and participate in this process, the IXC must order, install and maintain OTS trunks in every Local Access and Transport Area (LATA) where it provides service in order to receive OTS calls from the AT&T operator.

Today, customers are relying more and more on new technologies and/or services to communicate, such as smartphones, text messaging, instant messaging, social media, voicemail and email. As a result, fewer and fewer customers are using Operator Assistance, therefore, less and less customers are using OTS. The year over year trend reflects a 30% decrease in call volumes across the 20 AT&T states where the service is offered.

Customer notice has been sent to affected customers as required by D.07-09-019. A copy of the customer notice is included.

In compliance with General Order 96-B, we are serving a copy of this advice letter and related tariff sheets to interested parties who have requested. This filing will not increase any rate or charge or conflict with other schedules or rules.

The protest must state specifically the grounds on which it is based. The protest must be received by the Telecommunications Advice Letter Coordinator no later than 20 days after the date that the advice letter was filed.
