We attach for filing this Tier I advice letter to make the following changes in tariff sheets:

This filing revises Schedule Cal.P.U.C. No. 175-T Access Service, Section 7 Special Access Service, 7.2 Service Descriptions, 7.2.8 Digital Services, (C) High Capacity Service, to grandfather Flexible High Capacity Channel Mileage service, effective September 21, 2016. Existing customers, currently four in number, may keep this service until it is discontinued in 2017. Existing customers will receive another notice prior to the discontinuance of the service. The grandfathering of the service, originally planned for August 31, 2016, is now scheduled for September 21, 2016, due to a delay in the posting of a 60-day CLEC Accessible Letter.

Customer notice has been sent to affected customers as required by D.07-09-019. A copy of the customer notice is included.

In compliance with General Order 96-B, we are serving a copy of this advice letter and related tariff sheets to interested parties who have requested. This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

Anyone may object to this advice letter, which was filed September 21, 2016, by sending a written protest to: Telecommunications Advice Letter Coordinator, Communications Division, 505 Van Ness Avenue, 3rd Floor, San Francisco, CA 94102-3298. The protest must state specifically the grounds on which it is based. The protest must be received by the Telecommunications Advice Letter Coordinator no later than 20 days after the date that the advice letter was filed. On or before the day that the protest is sent to the Telecommunications Advice Letter Coordinator, the protestant must send a copy of the protest to Eric Batongbacal, 430 Bush Street, 5th Floor, San Francisco, CA 94108 (fax number 214.486.1580). (C) High Capacity Service (Cont'd)

(1) Basic Channel Description (Cont'd)

Channel mileage associated with High Capacity Service may be ordered at the 1.544 Mbps service level or as Flexible High Capacity Channel Mileage* available in groups of 4 (256 Kbps), 6 (384 Kbps), 8 (512 Kbps), 12 (768 Kbps) and 24 (1.544 Mbps) DS0 channels. Flexible High Capacity Channel Mileage is available only as a B8ZS/Extended Superframe Format service. Flexible High Capacity Channel Mileage channels are contiguous within the network and can be used to create a wideband circuit. These signals remain separately formatted within the DS-1 signal. (C)

Flexible High Capacity Channel mileage is available between all wire center areas served by the utility where suitable digital transmission facilities are available.

The customer may change from one Flexible High Capacity Channel Mileage service arrangement to another (e.g., the customer has an 8 channel arrangement and increases to an 12 channel arrangement, or has a 24 channel arrangement and decreases to 8 channels). This option is only available when the channel mileage was initially ordered as Flexible High Capacity Channel Mileage. A change in capacity charge will apply.

The customer may provide the Network Channel Terminating Equipment associated with the High Capacity channel at the customer's premises. The interim program for interconnection of such equipment is set forth in Technical Reference PUB AS No. 1.
