We attach for filing this Tier I advice letter to make the following changes in tariff sheets:

This filing revises Schedule Cal.P.U.C. No. A5. Exchange Services, 5.10 Exchange Boundary Maps, to realign the boundary between AT&T California's ("AT&T") Fontana Exchange and Frontier California's ("Frontier") Marshall Exchange.

This realignment results in the transfer of .2706 square miles to AT&T's Fontana Exchange from Frontier's Marshall Exchange (see attachments). The change has been requested so that AT&T can serve a new development where AT&T is already serving the adjacent properties. All parties agree that it would be the most cost effective arrangement for AT&T to serve the area.

There are no customers affected by this realignment.
