This filing revises Schedule Cal.P.U.C. No. A5. Exchange Services, 5.10 Exchange Boundary Maps, to realign the boundary between AT&T California's Avenal and Stratford Exchanges. AT&T California will transfer 5.139 square miles from the Stratford Exchange to the Avenal Exchange. Provisioning service from the Avenal Exchange will be the most cost effective to both future customers and AT&T California. There are no customers affected by this realignment. (See Attachments).
