This filing revises Schedule Cal.P.U.C. No. A5. Exchange Services, 5.2 Local Exchange Service, 5.2.5 Local Service Options, 5.2.5, E, to indicate the California LifeLine Program Fund will temporarily make up for the loss of federal funds for Lifeline participants who qualify under California LifeLine eligibility criteria but who do not meet federal Lifeline eligibility criteria, per Decision 18-02-006.

a. Service Connection Charge (Cont'd)

(2) The California LifeLine connection charge as set forth in 9.a.(6) preceding is applicable any time a qualifying household: (L)

(a) establishes California LifeLine,

(b) re-establishes California LifeLine at the same address at which California LifeLine was previously provided (even when the customer was disconnected for nonpayment),

(c) establishes California LifeLine at a new residence, or

(d) switches California LifeLine from one company to another. (L)

(3) The Company shall not impose a "central office charge" in addition to the California LifeLine connection charge when installing California LifeLine.

(4) Installation of a second and subsequent telephone service connection shall be subject to the Company's regular tariffed rates for these connections, except that low-income households with a disabled member may qualify for California LifeLine connection charges on two residential telephone connections.

(5) The Company may charge a late-payment fee when the California LifeLine customer fails to timely remit some or all of the California LifeLine connection charge under a deferred-payment schedule. (T)

b. Service Conversion Charges

The California LifeLine conversion charge as set forth in 9.a.(8) preceding is applied each time an existing customer changes class of service (from basic services to California LifeLine service) or when an existing customer enrolled in California LifeLine changes the type (measured vs. flat rate service) or grade (multi-party vs. one party) of service, including requests to change from Foreign Exchange Service.

There is no limit on the number of times a California LifeLine customer may pay the California LifeLine conversion charge to effect a change in the class, type or grade of service.

A customer shall not be charged a conversion fee in conjunction with a service connection charge.
