We attach for filing this Tier I advice letter to make the following changes in tariff sheets:

This filing revises Schedule Cal.P.U.C. No. 14. Wire Center and Meet Point Billing Information, to resolve sheet numbering issues in Advice Letter No. 47344, effective May 9, 2018. AL 47344 added sheets 618 through 626 to Section 13 (Additional Engineering, Additional Labor and Miscellaneous Services), causing a conflict with Section 14 for Sheet 618.

This tariff filing corrects the Original Sheet 618 in Section to 13 to the 2nd Revised Sheet 618. Material on the 1<sup>st</sup> Revised Sheet 618 in Section 14 is moved to Sheets 627 and 628 within Section 14. No text changes are being made with this filing.

13.3 Miscellaneous Services (Cont'd)

13.3.15 Billing Name and Address (BNA)

Billing Name and Address (BNA) provides the billing name and address associated with a telephone number for the purpose of billing a call.

At the request of a certificated Carrier or its authorized billing agent, the Utility will provision BNA Service. BNA Service will be provided to the Customer for the limited purpose of billing a call, where the originating telephone number is provided by the Customer, and the original telephone number was obtained through Automatic Number Identification (ANI).

BNA will be provided to the Customer in the industry supported Customer Account Record Exchange (CARE) format at the time the end user presubscribes to the Customer's service. Additional information will be provided to the Customer regarding end users presubscribed to the Customer, via the supported CARE format, advising the Customer when a toll restriction is either initiated and/or removed from the end user's account.

The Utility will bill Customers for BNA services under this tariff. The payment regulations set forth in Section 2.4 preceding apply.

14. Wire Center and Meet Point Billing Information\*

The National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 4 (NECA 4) contains information related to wire centers providing access service in Local Access and Transport Areas (LATAs) and Market Areas (MAs), subtending information identifying the relation-ship between wire centers for the ordering and provisioning of access services, and meet point billing information when two or more exchange carriers are jointly providing access service within or between LATAs or MAs under separate access tariffs.

NECA 4 also contains regulations for calculating the airline mileage between wire centers, on which certain access services are based, using the vertical and horizontal (V&H) coordinates method.

Sections 1 through 11 provide general information, including symbols, coding, and abbreviations, and mileage measurement regulations and methods.

Section 16 contains serving wire center V&H coordinate information for California.

Section 69 contains single state meet point billing information for California.

Section 125 contains multiple state meet point billing information for Arizona/California.

Section 127 contains multiple state meet point billing information for California/Nevada.

Section 195 contains multiple state meet point billing information for California/Oregon.
