Public Utilities Commission of the State of California

We submit this Tier I advice letter to make the following changes in tariff sheets:

SCHEDULE CAL.P.U.C. NO. A5

1716th Revised Check Sheet A
7th " Sheet 629

This submission revises Schedule Cal.P.U.C. No. A5. Exchange Services, 5.10 Exchange Boundary Maps, to realign the boundary between AT&T California's ("AT&T") Auburn Exchange and Frontier California Inc.'s ("Frontier") Weimar Exchange.

The purpose of this realignment is to accommodate the development of some parcels in the area that would be more easily, and cost effectively, served by AT&T. This realignment transfers 0.0177 square miles from Frontier's Weimar Exchange to AT&T's Auburn Exchange (see attachments). There are no customers affected by this realignment.

Frontier will also be submitting an advice letter this week regarding this same realignment.
