This filing revises Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A5. Exchange Services, 5.2 Local Exchange Service, 5.2.5 Universal Lifeline Telephone Service (California LifeLine), to increase the California LifeLine Carrier Credit from \$0.00 to \$0.02 to offset the \$0.02 increase in the Federal End User Common Line (EUCL) charge (also known as the Federal Subscriber Line Charge) that is effective July 2, 2019. There is no change in the monthly rates for California LifeLine customers.

This filing also revises Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A2, 2.1 Rules, 2.1.5 Information Required on Forms, to correct the zip code in the residence address and add a new business address, to which customers may write to AT&T. Programming changes have been submitted to update customer bills with the revised information.
