Pursuant to General Order 96-B, AT&T California (U-1001-C) submits this Advice Letter to make changes to its intrastate Network and Exchange Services Tariff Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A5, 5.2 Local Exchange Service, 5.2.5 Local Service Options, E. Universal Lifeline Telephone Service (California LifeLine).

The purpose of this filing is to rebalance lifeline credits due to a \$2.00 reduction in federal credit effective December 1, 2020. There is no change in rates for California LifeLine customers.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

This advice letter is submitted as a Tier I filing in accordance with General Order 96-B. AT&T California requests that this advice letter become effective on December 1, 2020.
