Re: AT&T Dedicated Ethernet Clean-up

Pursuant to General Order 96-B, AT&T California (U-1001-C) submits this Advice Letter to make changes to its intrastate Other Services Tariff, Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. D, Section D12. Special Access Service, D12.5 AT&T Dedicated Ethernet.

The purpose of this filing is to clean-up tariff references to the LATA (local access and transport area) by removing the terminology. In addition, a small correction has been made to add a previously omitted word. The changes will have no impact on the rates, terms or conditions of AT&T Dedicated Ethernet service.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

This advice letter is submitted as a Tier I filing in accordance with General Order 96-B. AT&T California requests that this advice letter become effective the same day as the submission date, September 1, 2020.

E. Meet Point Arrangements

In some cases, the Company and another Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier (ILEC, sometimes referred to as an Independent Company or ICO) may agree to jointly provide service where such service will be provided to locations in both the Company's and the other ILEC's serving territories. In such cases, the Company and the other ILEC may mutually agree to meet at a location (i.e., meet point) utilizing facilities suitable for delivery of AT&T Dedicated Ethernet. (D)

The Company is responsible for the ordering, provisioning, billing and maintenance of such AT&T Dedicated Ethernet service up to the meet point.

The rates and charges for AT&T Dedicated Ethernet are applicable for the Company provided portion of such service as follows:

- One Port Connection charge applies for the portion of the circuit provided by the Company.
- The Administrative Charge applies in full per order received.
- The Design and Central Office Connection Charge applies in full per AT&T Dedicated Ethernet circuit.
- The Customer Connection Charge applies for the termination of the Port Connection provided by the Company.

Service Level Agreement (SLA) credits in paragraph 12.5.4, A.1 will apply only to the Company provided portion of the service.

12.5.3 ETHERNET PAYMENT PLAN (EPP) (Cont'd)

B. Moves

Moves will be treated as a discontinuance of service and activation of new service. The previously waived non-recurring charges at the location(s) from which the circuit is being moved will be billed (if EPP term has not expired).

The Customer must select an EPP term for the new circuit. The new EPP term will be subject to the rates in effect at the time of the move. Termination Liability will apply for such a move except where all of the following conditions apply:

- The move is limited to one end of the AT&T Dedicated Ethernet circuit moving to a different Customer Site. (D) z
- The Customer's existing service must have been in place for at least 12 months.
- The Customer must select a new EPP with a term that is greater than or equal to the remainder of the existing EPP.
- Orders from the Customer to disconnect the existing service and reestablish service at the new location must be placed by the same Customer and received by the Company on the same date.
- No lapse in billing will occur for moves of service under an EPP. If the Customer requests that both the existing AT&T Dedicated Ethernet circuit and the new AT&T Dedicated Ethernet circuit be in service at the same time, such "overlapping" service shall be provided for no more than 30 days, and all applicable charges will be billed for both circuits during the period of overlapping service.
- Spare facilities and equipment must be available or *Special Construction* charges, as set forth in this Tariff, shall apply.
