In compliance with Decision (D.) 20-10-066, AT&T California (U-5002-C) submits this Advice Letter to provide details of its plan to eliminate California LifeLine Measured Rate Service.

Effective December 1, 2020, or thereafter as approved by the Commission, AT&T California will cease offering California LifeLine Measured Rate Service to new enrollees. On or after March 1, 2021, AT&T California will transition all existing California LifeLine Measured Rate Service customers to California LifeLine Flat Rate Service and provide a six month credit of \$2.00 to partially offset the price difference between California LifeLine Flat Rate Service and California LifeLine Measured Rate Service. Once this transition is completed, AT&T California will file an advice letter to withdraw California LifeLine Measured Rate Service from its tariff. Customers will be notified 30-60 days in advance of the expiration of their \$2.00 credit.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge or conflict with other schedules or rules.

This advice letter is submitted as a Tier II filing, as required in D. 20-10-066, in accordance with General Order 96-B. AT&T California requests that this advice letter become effective December 1, 2020, or upon approval by the California Public Utilities Commission.

California LifeLine, is a California Universal Service Public Policy Program that provides discounts on basic residential telephone service to eligible low-income households pursuant to the Moore Universal Telephone Service Act, General Order 153 and Resolution T-17366.

California LifeLine discounts are available to eligible customers ordering new, or currently subscribing to, the following basic services: flat rate individual service or measured rate individual service.

California LifeLine is available within all exchange areas as said areas are defined on maps filed as part of the tariff schedules.
