AT&T California (U-1001-C) submits this Advice Letter to revise its Schedule Cal.
P.U.C. No. 175-T. Access Service, Section 6. Switched Access Service, in
compliance with the FCC's 8YY Access Reform Report and Order (WC Docket No.
18-156).

This filing changes the following originating access rate elements to concur with Pacific
Bell Telephone Company's Tariff FCC No. 1.: Tandem Switch Transport, Tandem
Switching, Tandem Switched Transport/Common Transport, Local Switching, Shared End
Office Trunk Port Access Minutes and 800 (Toll Free Access) Database Query.

This filing does not increase any rates or charges or conflict with any other schedules or
rules.
