Pursuant to General Order 96-B, AT&T California (U-1001-C) submits this Supplemental Advice Letter No. 48982A to replace the revised tariff sheets submitted originally on December 30, 2021.

The December 30, 2021, submission had an error in the Specific Support Calculation. This supplemental submission changes the Specific Support Calculation from \$16.83 to \$16.23 and changes the CA Lifeline and Carrier Credit calculations accordingly.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service or conflict with other schedules or rules.

This supplement to the advice letter is submitted as a Tier I filing in accordance with General Order 96-B. AT&T California requests that this supplemental advice letter become effective on January 1, 2022.
