Re: Universal Service Public Purpose Programs Surcharge Revision

Pursuant to General Order 96-B, and in compliance with Decision 22-10-021 (issued October 24, 2022 and effective April 1, 2023), AT&T California (U-1001-C) submits this Tier 1 Advice Letter to revise AT&T California Schedule Cal. P.U.C. Nos. A (General Table of Contents), A1 (Preliminary Statement), A2 (General Regulations), A5 (Exchange Services), G2 (General Regulations) and 175-T (General Regulations). The purpose of this filing is to consolidate the Universal Service Public Purpose Programs ("PPP") surcharges into a single, flat rate per access line surcharge. This advice letter is effective April 1, 2023.

This advice letter will not cause the withdrawal of service or conflict with other schedules or rules. A copy of the customer notice is included.

2.1.37 RULE NO. 37 - SURCHARGE TO FUND CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION REIMBURSEMENT FEE

APPLICABILITY

This surcharge is for the purpose of funding the California Public Utilities Commission and applies to the aggregate amount of customer billings associated with intrastate billings which appear on customers' bills.

TERRITORY

Within the exchange areas of all exchanges as these areas are defined on maps filed as part of the tariff schedules.

RATES

SURCHARGE<sup>1</sup>

In accordance with the ordering paragraph of Resolution M-4866, a 0.75% surcharge shall be applied to all intrastate customer billings excluding yellow page directory revenues and direct sales and its associated provisions as they appear on the customer's bill. The surcharge will be applied to the customer's bill for intrastate services for all such services that appear on that particular bill, exclusive of federal and local excise taxes<sup>2</sup>.

The Utility shall not be liable for any and all penalties, losses or damages sustained by any carrier, or its customers, as a result of its use and concurrence of the Commission Reimbursement Fee rate contained (T) in the Utility's tariffs under Resolution T-16901.

NOTE 1: In 1983 the Legislature established the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee to be paid by Utilities to fund their regulation by the Commission (Public Utilities (PU) Code Section 401-443). The surcharge to recover the cost of that fee is ordered by the Commission under authority granted by PU Code Section 433. On December 15, 2022, Resolution M-4866 increased the fee from 0.52% to 0.75%, effective January 1, 2023.

NOTE 2: In accordance with Resolution T-17321 and Decision 10-11-033, effective December 1, 2011, this surcharge is no longer applied to customer billings for services provided under the California LifeLine program.

California Advanced Services Fund (CASF): supports the deployment of broadband facilities and broadband services adoption in unserved and underserved areas through project-specific grant funding.

California High Cost Fund-A (CHCF-A): provides subsidy to 10 of the 13 small local exchange carriers (LECs) for providing telephone service to residential customers in rural high cost areas.

California High Cost Fund-B (CHCF-B): provides subsidy to carriers of last resort for providing telephone service to residential customers in rural high-cost areas.

California Teleconnect Fund (CTF): provides a discount on select communications services to schools, libraries, hospitals, and other non-profit organizations (see Rule No. 41).

Deaf and Disabled Telecommunications Program (DDTP): provides telecommunications devices to deaf or hearing impaired consumers.

Universal LifeLine Telephone Service (ULTS): provides discounted home phone and cellular phone services to qualifying households. (C)

No. A3. Pursuant to Decision No. 87-04-027 products and services for certified disabled individuals will also be made available at no charge. The cost of providing such minimum basic equipment features will be charged to a Trust Fund.

Pursuant to Decision 22-10-021, a per access line surcharge will be applied to all telecommunication utility subscribers' intrastate tariffed services, both within a service area and between service areas to support the funding of the Deaf and Disabled Telecommunications Program in addition to other Universal Service Public Purpose Programs. 2.1.30 RULE NO. 30 - LOCAL NUMBER PORTABILITY

The rules and regulations for Directory Number Call Forwarding (DNCF) service set forth in California Guidebook Part 24, Section 3 shall apply to DNCF services purchased in association with DID trunks, PRI Service, or SuperTrunk serviced provided pursuant to this tariff. The rates shall be set on an individual cases basis.

Inward DNCF may be offered as an interim service offering within a rate area until Local Number Portability is implemented in the respective Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA). Inward DNCF may also be offered as a permanent service offering in those areas that are not scheduled for LNP capability pursuant to the LNP MSA conversion schedules. The rates shall be set on an individual cases basis.

When a customer chooses to terminate DNCF service, a telephone number that is homed on a Utility switch will be retained by the Utility.

When a customer chooses to terminate DNCF service and the telephone number is homed on a non-Utility switch, the customer must contact the other telephone company owning the switch where the telephone number is homed to make arrangements to port the number.

2.4 Payment Arrangements and Credit Allowances (Cont'd)

2.4.10 All Special Access Services and IEC Directory Assistance Services are authorized by D.94-09-065, as flexibly priced services. The monthly rates and installation charges may be increased (not to exceed the ceiling on file with the Commission) by the Utility upon at least 30 days prior notice to the CPUC and affected customers or decreased (not below the floor on file with the Commission) by the Utility upon at least ten days prior notice to the CPUC and affected customers.

2.4.11 Application of Surcharges

(A) Pursuant to Decision 22-10-021, all intrastate end user telecommunications services provided by certificated telecommunications companies will be subject to a surcharge to support California Universal Service Public Purpose Programs (PPPs). For the PPP surcharge amount and regulations, please refer to AT&T California's Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A2 (Rule No. 38). Programs for which the surcharge will fund include:
