Pursuant to General Order 96-B, AT&T California (U-1001-C) submits this Tier 1 Advice Letter to revise AT&T California Schedule Cal. P.U.C. Nos. B, B1, B2, B3, B5, B7, B9, B10, and B11. The purpose of this filing is to withdraw certain grandfathered private line services and make text changes. This advice letter is effective March 1, 2024.

This advice letter will not cause a rate increase or conflict with other schedules or rules. There are no customers subscribing to the services being withdrawn.
