Re: CA Lifeline Rebalance Due to EUCL Change

Pursuant to General Order 96-B, AT&T California (U-1001-C) (AT&T) submits this Advice Letter to make changes to its intrastate tariff Schedule Cal.P.U.C. No. A5. Exchange Services, 5.2 Local Exchange Service, 5.2.5 Universal Lifeline Telephone Service (California LifeLine), to decrease the California LifeLine Carrier Credit due to a decrease in the Federal End User Common Line (EUCL) charge (also known as the Federal Subscriber Line Charge) which decreased from \$6.22 to \$6.16 effective July 1, 2026. There are no changes in the monthly rates for California LifeLine customers.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

This advice letter is submitted as a Tier I filing in accordance with General Order 96-B. AT&T California requests that this advice letter become effective on July 1, 2026.
