A. DESCRIPTION

C. EARLY TERMINATION

Early Termination Charges will be assessed unless the customer retains at least one access line installed under this offer for the entire 12 month term.

1-2-3 PUNCH offers the waiver of all nonrecurring charges applicable to the service order and installation of new Business access lines of customers that currently do not have service with the Company. Also, existing qualifying Company customers are eligible for a one-time credit.

Any business customer that does not currently have service with the Company must order 1, 2, or 3 business access lines and retains the main billing telephone number for a minimum of one-year will receive a waiver of the nonrecurring charges (NRC) for each of those lines. d. (Cont'd)

(2) Farmer line customers will normally provide, own and maintain all lines and facilities beyond the boundary of the base rate area or beyond the point of connection of existing facilities as designated by the Company.

(3) The Standard Network Interface (SNI) will be located at a suitable point on the customer's property as determined by the Company, except as follows: Remote SNIs (SNIs not located at the customer's property) will only be installed at another property if the farmer line customer has obtained permission (in writing) from the owner of such property. If the Company's service facilities or the customer's farmer line are installed on property other than the customer's property and the owner of such property revokes their permission to use it, the Company shall have the right to discontinue service upon 10 days written notice, without obligation or liability to the customer. If service is discontinued under these conditions, the customer may have service reestablished under the provisions of Guidebook, Part 4, Section 5.

(4) Farmer line service will be furnished provided the line and other facilities owned by the customers are suitable for telephone use and are in an operating condition. The Company reserves the right to discontinue telephone service to a customer or customers served by a farmer line by disconnection of such farmer line if a fault in any part of the line or other facilities provided by the customer or customers causes interference with service furnished to other customers, and may refuse to reconnect the line until the fault is corrected and the line and other customer-owned facilities are placed in an operating condition.
