 - i. Service will be furnished to Multiparty Farmer Lines:
 - To less than three customers provided the total minimum exchange revenue of each circuit is not less than that of three residence stations.
 - (2) To two or more customers or lines on a single service arrangement.
 - j. Multiparty Line Services

Farmer line will be furnished only to a designated secretary or manager who will be considered to be the customer and who will be responsible for the payment of charges and other obligations in connection with the use of the service. It shall be the duty of the members of each farmer line to appoint or designate a secretary or manager for such line and no new member shall thereafter be connected to said line nor will the Company assign a number to a new member on such line except on written authority from such secretary or manager. Telephone service will be furnished to a farmer line only when service at the following rates is subscribed for in connection with each telephone connected to the line. Should a telephone for which service has not been subscribed be connected to a line, it shall be the duty of the secretary or manager to disconnect such telephone and refuse to permit its reconnection until proper arrangements have been made for service with both the manager of the line and the Company. The Company shall render bills for exchange and toll service to the individual members of the farmer line unless requested to do otherwise by the secretary or manager.
