Requires suitably equipped ISDN switching and terminal equipment and allows the Company's network to pass Message Waiting Indication information between multiple entities within a PRI network serving arrangement

5. Network Ring Again

This feature allows a calling station which encounters a busy to notify the central office switch to signal the calling station when the called station becomes idle. The calling station can then notify the switch to complete the call.

6. Non-PRI Foreign Exchange/Foreign Prefix Connection

Allows PRI customers to request telephone numbers to be trunked in from remote offices to the PRI serving switch for use over the PRI. The connection charge is in addition to the Rates and Charges for the Foreign Exchange and/or Foreign Prefix Service(s) as set forth in California Guidebook part 4 Section 3, and applies to each path (telephone number) so connected. The Non-PRI Foreign Exchange/Foreign Prefix Connection Charge does not apply to telephone numbers assigned directly from the PRI serving central office.

7. PRI Subgroup

Where facilities and operating conditions permit, PRI Subgroup allows customers who subscribe to multiple associated service types within a single PRI serving arrangement to create subgroups, thereby dedicating a certain number of channels to a particular service type.
