2. ISDN - BASIC RATE INTERFACE (ISDN-BRI) /2/

Effective September 1, 2021, ISDN-BRI will no longer be available for purchase by new or existing customers. In addition, requests to move, add, change, or renew existing service arrangements will not be accepted. The Company will continue to provide existing service to existing customers until the expiration of a customer's term agreement. Following the expiration of a customer's existing term agreement, service will be provided on a month-to-month basis at the applicable Monthly Extension rates until the service is discontinued. The Company currently plans to discontinue this service on or after August 1, 2023. (N)
