## **B.** Cost Assessment Charge

A Cost Assessment Charge (CAC) is assessed on a percentage basis against all billed revenue for business customers subscribing to the private line services listed below. The CAC is established to recover property taxes. This charge is not a tax or fee that the government requires the Company to collect from customers. The following account types are not assessed a CAC: Federal, State and Local Government accounts; Resale accounts; and accounts designated by the Company as Wholesale.
