2.1 Undertaking of the Telephone Company (Cont'd)

2.1.10 Notification of Service-Affecting Activities

The Telephone Company will provide the customer reasonable notification of service-affecting activities that may occur in normal operation of its business. Such activities may include but are not limited to, equipment or facilities additions, removals or rearrangements, routine preventative maintenance and major switching machine change-out. Generally, such activities are not individual customer service specific, they affect many customer services. No specific advance notification period is applicable to all service activities. The Telephone Company will work cooperatively with the customer to determine the notification requirements.

2.1.11 Coordination with Respect to Network Contingencies

The Telephone Company intends to work cooperatively with the customer to develop network contingency plans in order to maintain maximum network capability following natural or man-made disasters which affect telecommunications services.

2.1.12 Provision and Ownership of Telephone Numbers

The Telephone Company reserves the reasonable right to assign, designate or change telephone numbers, or any other call number designations associated with Access Services, or the Telephone Company serving central office prefixes associated with such numbers, when necessary in the conduct of its business. Should it become necessary to make a change in such number(s), the Telephone Company will furnish to the customer reasonable notice, by Certified U.S. Mail of the effective date and an explanation of the reason(s) for such change(s).

2.1.13 Metropolitan Statistical Area Access Services

For the Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in which the Telephone Company has received Phase II pricing flexibility, pursuant to Subpart H of Part 69 of the Commission's Rules. Section 22 of this Tariff governs the offering of service in these MSAs. Upon approval of Phase II pricing flexibility for a petitioned MSA, services purchased via Sections 6, 7, 8, 20, 22, 25, 26, 27, 30 and 32, under the various Pricing Plans as identified in Section 22.4(F), will then become subject to the regulations in Section 22, Metropolitan Statistical Area Access Services.

2.1.14 Broadband Services

Pursuant to the detariffing authority granted by the Commission in Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 07-180 (released October 12, 2007), certain broadband services have been withdrawn from this tariff. When offering these services through non-tariffed arrangements, the Telephone Company will abide by all of the special access merger commitments set forth in Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 06-189 at Appendix F (released March 26, 2007), including but not limited to commitments that contain references to "tariffs," such as those addressing pricing dispute resolution, and access service ratio terms. The detariffing of these services does not diminish or supersede any of those special access merger commitments.

The Telephone Company will offer a service date based on the type and quantity of Access Services the customer has requested. Certain Telephone Company critical dates are associated with the service interval. These dates provide a means to determine the provisioning costs incurred at any point during the service interval. When the customer requests a 0-2 day expedite interval, on DS3, Analog (Metallic, Telegraph, Direct Analog, Wideband Analog), DS0 (Wideband Data, Base Rate), DS1 128, 256, 384, 512, 768 Kbps, Entrance Facilities (Voice Grade, DS1, DS3) and DS1/DS3 Access Service, the request must be received by the Telephone Company by 8:30AM (PT), Monday-Friday. All 0-2 day expedite interval requests received after 8:30AM (PT) will reflect an application date of the next business day and the due date will also be changed to the next business day. Expedite charges will be determined by the interval between the application date and the expedite due date.

If, upon reviewing availability of equipment, facilities and scheduled workload, the Telephone Company agrees to provide service on an expedited basis and the customer accepts this proposal, an Expedite Order Charge (in case of DSO, Fractional DS1, Voice Grade/DS1 Entrance Facilities and High Capacity DS1 Access Services) or Expedite Circuit Charge (in case of DS3 Entrance Facilities, High Capacity DS3 Access Services) apply.

The maximum number of circuits, which may be expedited, is limited to twelve (12) two-point or six (6) multi-point Analog/DSO circuits at the same location; a limit of nine (9) DS1 circuits at the same location; a limit of four (4) Fractional DS1 circuits at the same location; and a limit of two (2) DS3 circuit at the same location. 8.2 Route Diversity

MON Ring Service is configured with diversely routed fiber whenever possible. Unprotected channels will be lost in the event of a fiber path failure on which the circuit is assigned. Equipment interfaces towards the customer are not protected.

Routing of fiber may be diversified from the customer premises to their serving wire center or alternate serving wire center as determined by the Telephone Company, and where facilities are available, to ensure that loop fibers follow separate paths to the serving wire center or alternate serving wire center. In addition, IOF (interoffice facility) fiber paths may be diversified to ensure that at any serving wire center drop node, the fibers do not egress and ingress at the same location. In cases, where the serving wire center does not have multiple entrance fiber facilities, the section of the fiber from the manhole closest to the serving wire center will be routed within the same duct structure.

At the customer's request, additional protection to the customer premises nodes can be provided via dual entrance facilities. This special request will cause the customer to incur special construction cost. Without this special request, diverse fiber is provided to the manhole closest to the customer premises. The customer or building owner is responsible for providing the conduit.

In the case where dual entrance facilities are not established at the customer premises, collapsed facilities from the customer premises to the building equipment location are not diverse.

8.3 Rate Regulations

(A) Rate Elements

There are nine basic rate elements which apply to the MON Ring Service:

(1) Nonrecurring Charges

These are one-time charges that apply for specific work activities (i.e., installation of new service, moves, and rearrangements of installed services). There are three different nonrecurring charges:

- (a) Administrative Charge applies any time a customer initiates an order for service. This charge applies once per customer order.
- (b) Design and Central Office Connection Charge applies once for the initial MON Ring installation, and applies once for each circuit ordered on the MON Ring Service.
- (c) Customer Connection Charge applies to establish the MON Ring network, and is charged per node. Subsequent installation charges apply to each subsequent shelf installed after the MON Ring network is established.

(2) Customer Premises Node

Provides for the termination of service at the customer's premises and presents the various selected ports to the customer. Applies per customer designated premises, per first shelf and subsequent shelves.

(3) Central Office Node

Provides for the termination of service at a Telephone Company serving wire center. Applies per first shelf and subsequent shelves.

(4) Channel Mileage

Provides for the transmission facilities between the serving wire centers associated with the customer designated premises. The mileage measurement is developed utilizing the V&H coordinate method as set forth in the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. (NECA) Wire Center Information Tariff, F.C.C. No. 4. A one-mile minimum will be billed between nodes. A two-node ring configuration has a two mile minimum, one mile from the central office node to the customer premises node, and one mile from the customer premises node to the central office node.

(5) Optical Amplifier

Provides for an optical signal boost and applies when the distance between nodes exceeds the transmission loss parameters (link loss specific). Optical amplifiers are located at the customer premises node, a central office node, or a serving wire center. Each amplifier provides amplification for up to 16 channels per location (one amplifier per C or L band). Available where facilities and equipment permit $^{(1)}$.

(6) Regenerator

Provides for re-timing, re-shaping, and regeneration when the degradation of the signal exceeds the dispersion and/or optical amplifier noise limits. Applies on a per shelf basis for up to 2.5 Gbps services and on a per circuit basis for up to 10 Gbps service.

(7) <u>Bulk Power</u>

Provides for customer premises node power, which will be required if the customer's power source is AC. Applies once per 4 shelves, with the first shelf and fifth subsequent shelf at each applicable customer premises node.

22. Metropolitan Statistical Area Access Services

22.1 General Description

(A) This section of the tariff provides the regulations, rates and terms and conditions that apply to telecommunications services provided by the Telephone Company in the Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in which the Telephone Company has received Phase II pricing flexibility pursuant to Subpart H of Part 69 of the Commission's Rules. MSAs are divided into the categories below:

(1) Full Service MSAs

Full Service Relief MSAs are those MSAs which qualified for Phase II pricing flexibility for all elements of service, i.e., local channels (channel terminations) between LEC end offices and customer (end user) premises; entrance facilities; dedicated interoffice facilities; local channels (channel terminations) between an interexchange carrier's point of presence and a serving wire center. The Full Service Relief MSAs are set forth in Section 22.2(A), following.

(2) Limited Service MSAs

Limited Service Relief MSAs are those MSAs that qualified for Phase II pricing flexibility for all elements of service except local channels (channel terminations) between a LEC end office and a customer (end user) premise. The Limited Service Relief MSAs are set forth in Section 22.2(B), following.

- (B) The services provided in MSAs pursuant to this section of the tariff are set forth in Section 22.3, following. These services are comparable to the SWA Dedicated Transport Services in Sections 6.8.1(A), 6.8.1(B), 6.8.1(I), and the Special Access Services in Sections 7, 20 and 22. (1) The general regulations, service descriptions, and rate regulations for the SWA Dedicated Transport Services in Section 6 and the Special Access Services in Sections 7 and 20 (1) are also applicable to the services specified in this section, except as provided below.
 - An exception in 22.4(F) applies for term pricing plans.
- (B) Unless otherwise provided for in this section, regulations set forth in Sections 1, 2, 5, and 13 are also applicable.







28. AT&T Volume Discount Plan (AVDP)

28.1 General Description

The AVDP provides volume discounts applicable to the interstate term plans listed below, for Customers who purchase DS1 and DS3 (D) at the volume tiers outlined in Section 28.1 (B). The AVDP provides a Billing Credit Discount (BCD) annually, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth below:

(A) Terms and Conditions

- (1) The AT&T Volume Discount Plan is available for DS1 and DS3 (D) channel terminations purchased for one, three and five-year term periods:
 - (a) DS1 TPP (Sections 7.11.5.2, 7.11.5.3(F) and 22.5.2.6); and
 - (b) DS3 High Capacity Service Billing Period (Sections 7.11.5.1(A), 7.11.5.3 and 22.5.2.5).
 - (1) (1)
- (2) To subscribe to the AVDP, the Customer must provide written notification to its Telephone Company account manager or the Business Office.
- (2) Circuits ordered on or after March 14, 2007, or circuits which have completed a term period and are subscribed to a new term period on or after March 14, 2007, under one, three and five-year term plans described in 28.1(A)(1), will count toward the volume levels identified in Section 28.1(B) from the day the Customer has notified the Telephone Company of its subscription to AVDP.
- (4) AVDP expires on December 31, 2010. The last BCD will be paid in January 2011.
- (5) The Customer's BCD is identified by referencing the Billing Credit Discount Table in 28.1(B) using the monthly in-service volumes, aggregated by service type. The Average Monthly In-Service Volume (AMISV) is calculated by totaling the number of channel terminations by service each month, and dividing the total by the number of subscribed months in the plan year. See example of BCD calculation in 28.1(B).
- (6) The BCD is applied as a percentage discount to the total monthly recurring billed revenue for channel terminations, by service, for the subscription period of the current year for the services identified in Section 28.1(B). The BCD will be paid as an annual discount credit to the Customer's bill in January of the following year for subscribed services in 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010.
- (7) Services subject to the Customer's Managed Value Plan or a Price Flex Contract Tariff are not eligible for the AVDP offering.
