(1)As of October 6, 2004, PPS Interface Arrangement service utilizing the X.25 protocol and the X.75 protocol is obsolete and is limited to existing installations, at existing locations, for existing customers.

(B) When a Credit Allowance Applies (Cont'd)

- (3) For Special Access, Metallic, Telegraph, Voice Grades, Generic Digital Transport Service (GDTS) and High Capacity and Fiber AdvantageSM DS1, DS3, DS3x3 DS3x12, Program Audio, Video,⁽¹⁾ and for the Switched Transport portion of Switched (D) Access service the customer shall be credited the amount specified below for service interruptions equal to 4 hours or more, as the Maintenance Commitment Program (MCP) credit. The credit allowance described in Section 2.4.4(B)(1) will continue to apply to interruptions that are less than 4 hours.

Only 1 MCP credit allowance will be applied per affected service during a 30 day period. The total credit allowance available to the customer regardless of the number of service interruptions within a 30 day period will not exceed 100% of the combined monthly rates per affected service. Additional service interruptions that occur in the same 30 day period will be calculated as described in Section 2.4.4(B)(1). (T)

Except for new installations, credit shall be computed using the beginning of the prior month's billing records. For new services, the credit shall be determined using the beginning of the current month's billing records.

To qualify for the MCP credit, the customer will provide to the Telephone Company the name and number of the customer's personnel accepting the closure. The Telephone Company will provide the date and time the trouble was reported to Pacific Bell and the date and time the service was returned to the customer. If this information is not provided, the credit allowance described in Section 2.4.4(B)(1) will apply.

- (6) For Switched Access Service interruptions on a per line or per trunk basis, no credit shall be allowed for an interruption of less than 24 hours. The customer shall be credited for an interruption of 24 hours or more at the rate of 1/30 of any applicable monthly rates and/or the assumed minutes of use charge for each period of 24 hours or major fraction thereof that the interruption continues.

For Switched Access Service interruptions on a total switch outage basis, no credit shall be allowed for an interruption of less than 8 hours. The customer shall be credited for an interruption of 8 hours or more at the rate of 1/90 of any applicable monthly rates and/or the assumed minutes of use charge for each period of 8 hours or major fraction thereof that the interruption continues.

- (7) The credit allowance(s) in a given month, for an interruption or for a series of interruptions occurring during that month, shall not exceed the sum of applicable monthly rates plus the assumed minutes of use charge.
- (8) For certain Special Access services (WD1-4; Generic Digital Transport Service, DA1-6; and High Capacity, HC1), any period during which the error performance is below that specified for the service will be considered as an interruption. (D)

If a customer desires that service be provided on a due date earlier than the standard interval, the customer may request that service be provided on an expedited service interval. To qualify for an expedited interval the customer must provide End User premises access, where needed, until 11PM (PT), Monday-Friday.

When the customer requests a 0-2 day expedite interval, on DS3, Analog (Metallic, Telegraph, Direct Analog), DS0 (Base Rate), DS1 (D) 128, 256, 384, 512, 768 Kbps, Entrance Facilities (Voice Grade, DS1, DS3) and DS1/DS3 Access Service, the request must be received by the Telephone Company by 8:30AM (PT), Monday-Friday. All 0-2 day expedite interval requests received after 8:30AM (PT) will reflect an application date of the next business day and the due date will also be changed to the next business day. Expedite charges will be determined by the interval between the application date and the expedite due date.

If, upon reviewing availability of equipment, facilities and scheduled workload, the Telephone Company agrees to provide service on an expedited basis and the customer accepts this proposal, an Expedite Order Charge (in case of Analog, DS0, Fractional DS1, Voice Grade/DS1 Entrance Facilities and High Capacity DS1 Access Services) or Expedite Circuit Charge (in case of DS3 Entrance Facilities, High Capacity DS3, DS3x3 and DS3x12 Access Services, ⁽¹⁾ will apply.

The maximum number of circuits, which may be expedited, is limited to twelve (12) two-point or six (6) multi-point Analog/DS0 circuits at the same location; a limit of nine (9) DS1 circuits at the same location; a limit of four (4) Fractional DS1 circuits at the same locations; and a limit of two (2) DS3 circuit at the same location. ⁽¹⁾ When the number of access circuits exceeds the maximum threshold the interval will be negotiated.

If the Telephone Company determines that service can be provided on an expedited basis, the following charges will apply based upon agreed upon expedited service interval. The Expedited Order Charge (in case of Analog, DS0, Fractional DS1, Voice Grade/DS1 Entrance Facilities and High Capacity DS1 Access Services) applies on a per order basis, regardless of the number of circuits. The Expedited Circuit Charge (in case of DS3 Entrance Facilities, High Capacity DS3, DS3x3 and DS3x12 Access Services) ⁽¹⁾ applies on a per circuit basis.

If the customer desires that service be provided on an earlier date than that which has been established for the access order or the provision of the Access Service, the customer may request that service be provided on an expedited basis. If the Telephone Company determines that service can be provided on the requested date and that additional labor costs or extraordinary costs are required to meet the requested service date, the customer will be notified and will be provided with an estimate of the additional charges involved. The total charge to the customer for the Additional Engineering may not exceed the estimated amount by more than 10%. If the customer instructs the Telephone Company to proceed, such additional charges will be determined and billed to the customer as follows:

To calculate the additional labor charges, the Telephone Company will, upon authorization from the customer to incur the additional labor charges, keep track of the additional labor hours used to meet the request of the customer and will bill the customer at the applicable additional labor charges as set forth in Section 13.2.6. (T)

- (a) Extraordinary Costs: The special construction terms and conditions specified in Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 will be used by the Telephone Company to determine charges to recover the extraordinary costs which may be involved. Authorization to incur the costs and to bill the customer will be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Tariff F.C.C. No. 2.
- (b) When the request for expediting occurs subsequent to the issuance of the access order, a Service Date Change Charge as specified in Section 5.2.2(A) also applies. (T)

At no additional charge, the Telephone Company will, at the customer's request, cooperatively test at the time of installation, the following parameters:

- (A) For Voice Grade analog services, acceptance tests will include tests for loss, 3-tone slope, DC continuity, operational signaling, C-notched noise, and C-message noise when these parameters are applicable and specified in the order for service. Additionally, for Voice Grade Services, a balance (improved loss) test will be made if the customer has ordered the improved loss optional feature.
- (B) For other analog services (i.e., Metallic, Telegraph, Program Audio, Video, and WATS Access Line) and for digital services (i.e., Generic Digital Transport and High Capacity), acceptance tests will include tests for the parameters applicable to the service as specified in the order for service. (D)

In addition to the above tests, Additional Cooperative Acceptance Testing for Voice Grade Service to test other parameters, as described in Section 13.3.5(B), is available at the customer's request. All tests results will be made available to the customer upon request. (T)

(D) Crediting the Surcharge

The Telephone Company will cease billing the Special Access Surcharge when certification that the Special Access Service has become exempt from the surcharge, as set forth in (B) preceding is received. If the status of the Special Access Service was changed prior to receipt of the exemption certification, the Telephone Company will credit the customer's account, not to exceed ninety (90) days, based on the effective date of the change specified by the customer in the letter of certification.

(E) Application of Rates

(1) The monthly Special Access Surcharge applies to Special Access Service arranged, as set forth in (A) preceding, on a per voice equivalent basis as shown in the following example:

* The Special Access Surcharge is assessed 24 times on a two-point service only when the DS1 service is not multiplexed by the Telephone Company. When the DS1 service is multiplexed by the Telephone Company, the Special Access Surcharge is then assessed on each individual channelized line as it is installed. No surcharge is assessed on unused channels of the DS1 when it is multiplexed by the Telephone Company.

The Telephone Company will commence billing the monthly rate for the High Capacity facilities to the Hub and the associated multiplexer on the date specified by the customer on the service order. Individual services utilizing these facilities may be installed coincident with the installation of the facility to the Hub, or may be ordered and/or installed at a later date, at the option of the customer. Individual service rates (e.g., Voice Grade, Metallic or GDTs Service) will apply for a Channel Termination and additional Channel Mileage (as required) for each channelized service. Channel Termination charges are not applied at Hubs when, by customer request, individual services are channelized by Telephone Company multiplexers. These will be billed to the customer as each individual service is installed. A High Capacity service may not be ordered with multiplexing to lower levels at both ends.

(D)

When cascading multiplexing is performed, whether in the same or a different Hub, a charge for the additional multiplexing unit also applies. When cascading multiplexing is performed at different Hubbing locations, Channel Mileage charges also apply between the Hubs at the appropriate service level (e.g., DS1 or DS3).

When a DS3x3 or DS3x12 is hubbed and segregated into individual DS3 services, a separate multiplexer charge is not required between the DS3x3 or DS3x12 service and the individual DS3 services. DS3 rates and charges will apply to the individual DS3 services as required (e.g., channel termination, channel mileage and optional features if requested). If multiplexing is used to multiplex DS3x3 or DS3x12 service to DS1 service, then at least one DS3 to DS1 multiplexer is required.

Shared use occurs when Special Access Service and Switched Access Service are provided over the same High Capacity or SONET Ring and Access Services⁽¹⁾ facilities through a common interface. The High Capacity or SONET Ring and Access Services⁽¹⁾ facility will be ordered, provided and rated as Special Access Service (i.e., Channel Termination, Mileage, as appropriate, and multiplier or rate element of SONET Ring and Access Services⁽¹⁾). (D)

The customer must place an order for each individual Switched or Special Access Service utilizing the shared use Facilities and specify the channel assignment for each service. (D)

Rates and Charges as described in Sections 7.4.1 and 7.5 will apply when each individual channel of the Shared Use facility is used to provide the Special Access service. (T)

Rates and Charges as set forth in Section 6.8 will apply when each individual channel of the Shared Use facility is used to provide Switched Access service. As each individual Switched Access service channel is activated, the High Capacity Channel Termination, Channel Mileage and Multiplier rates or SONET Ring and Access Service⁽¹⁾ rates will be reduced accordingly, e.g., 1/24th for DS1 service, 1/672nd for DS3 service, 1/2016th for DS3x3 or OC3 service, 1/8064th for OC12 or equivalent service and 1/32,256th for OC48 or equivalent service. (D)

⁽¹⁾ Effective 01/03/06, SONET Ring and Access Service is limited to existing customers at existing locations except where spare capacity exists; customers may add additional locations on existing rings. New SONET ring services will be provided via Dedicated SONET Ring Service.
