5.6.1 Minimum Period Charges

(F) Should billing for a service which is disconnected prior to the expiration of the Minimum Period cover multiple billing cycles, the bill reflecting the disconnect of service will be adjusted to account for that portion of the Minimum Period Charge previously billed to the customer. In no event shall the total recurring charge billed to the customer for such service exceed the applicable Minimum Period Charge.

All applicable nonrecurring charges associated with the provision of service will be billed in addition to the Minimum Period Charge. Such nonrecurring charges include the nonrecurring charge for the installation of service and/or optional features, Service Order Modification Charges, Additional Engineering and Labor Charges, if any, etc.

5.7 <u>Shared Use Facilities</u>

Shared Use (i.e. BellSouth SWA and BellSouth Expanded Interconnection (C) services provided over Special Access (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA)) is allowed. All Shared Use facilities will be ordered and provided as Special Access (a.k.a BellSouth SPA). While Shared Use is allowed, individual services utilizing these facilities must be ordered as BellSouth SWA, Special Access (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA) or Virtual Access (C) Cross Connect, Physical Access Cross Connect, or Intra-Office (N) Collocation Cross Connect Service. When placing the order for I individual service (s) the customer must specify a channel assignment (N) for each service ordered. Shared Use of BellSouth SWA facilities (i.e. Special Access (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA provided over BellSouth SWA) is not allowed.

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5.8 <u>Available Inventory</u>

The Toll Free Dialing Database rate category includes the use of transmission facilities and functions between a Service Switching Point (SSP) equipped end office or access tandem and a Service Control Point (SCP) by the Telephone Company to provide for BellSouth SWA 8XX Toll Free Dialing Ten Digit Screening Service. Rate elements and rates associated with this category are provided in 6.8.11, following.

(F) BellSouth Local Number Portability Database Services

The BellSouth Local Number Portability Database services rate category includes the use of transmission facilities and functions between (1) a Service Switching Point (SSP) equipped end office or access tandem and a Service Control Point (SCP), or (2) a STP and SCP by the Telephone Company to provide for BellSouth Local Number Portability Database services. Rate elements and rates associated with this category are provided in 6.8.12, following.

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LightGate Service (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA Point to Point Network), in Section 7 following, provides SONET transport capabilities in a pointto-point configuration. LightGate Service (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA Point to Point Network) provides the capability for a customer to activate SONET transport arrangements at STS-1, OC-3, OC-12, OC-48 or OC-192 transmission speeds. For the purposes of shared use calculations, local channel and interoffice channel interfaces in Section 7, following, associated with LightGate Service (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA Point to Point Network) are grouped in the Channel System, Synchronous Channel Interface rate element category for BellSouth SWA SONET Transport Components.

6.7.14 Shared Use

When a BellSouth SWA service is provided over the same Special Access (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA) facility through a common interface, the facility will be ordered, provided, and rated only as Special Access (BellSouth SPA) service as set forth in 7.4.8 following. Shared use of BellSouth SWA facilities (i.e., (C) N) Special Access (a.k.a BellSouth SPA) services provided over Bellsouth SWA facilities) is not allowed

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6.7.15 <u>Information Surcharge</u>

The Information Surcharge is a charge to recover costs that have been assigned to the interstate Information category through Parts 36 and 69 of the Commission's Rules. These costs are other than those incurred in the provision of interstate BellSouth Directory Assistance Access service as set forth in Section 9 following.

The Information Surcharge is assessed to the customer based on the total number of access minutes. The rates are set forth in 6.8.4 following. The application of these rates with respect to the individual BellSouth SWA FGs and BellSouth SWA Basic Serving Arrangements, are as set forth in 6.7.1(E) preceding.

6.7.16 Shared Network Arrangement

Shared Network Arrangement provides for multiple customers to connect their individual services on channelized High Capacity Service. These service configurations will be limited to BellSouth SWA DS3 service customers sharing capacity with other sub-DS3 service customers and/or BellSouth SWA DS1 service customers sharing capacity with other sub-DS1 customers. Additional regulations for Shared Network Arrangements are as follows in 7.4.11.

A one-time coordination charge will be assessed with the establishment of a Shared Network Arrangement. In addition to the coordination charge, a separate nonrecurring charge will apply to each service order on a shared network account. Applicable nonrecurring charges apply as set forth in 6.8.7 following.

7.4.7 Facility Hubs (Cont'd)

Cascading channelization occurs when a high capacity (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA High Capacity) analog or digital channel is channelized to provide channels with a lesser capacity and one of the lesser capacity channels is further channelized. For example, a Supergroup facility is channelized to five Group facilities and then one of the Group facilities is further channelized to individual Voice Grade (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA DSO VG) channels.

When cascading channelization is performed, whether in the same or a different Hub, a charge for the additional Basic Channelization System and Central Office Channel Interface(s) also applies. A DS1 (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA DS1) Basic Channelization System and DDAS⁽²⁾ (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA DSO Digital Data) Central Office Channel Interface are required for high speed or low speed DDAS⁽²⁾ (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA DSO Digital Data) activations when channelized from a DS1 (1.544 Mbps) channel. A DS0 Basic Channelization System and Subrate Central Office Channel Interface are required for subrate activations of 2.4, 4.8 and 9.6 Kbps when channelized from a DS0⁽²⁾ (64 Kbps) channel. When cascading channelization is performed at different Hubbing locations, Interoffice Channel charges also apply between the Hubs.

Although not requiring channelization, the Telephone Company will designate certain Hubs for Program Audio⁽¹⁾⁽³⁾ (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA Program Audio) service. A customer can order full-time and/or part-time service(s) between customer designated premises and a Hub and will be billed accordingly at the rates set forth in Section 7.5.4 for the full-time or part-time service, as appropriate. At the request of a customer, the full-time and/or part-time services provided to the Hub may be connected together in the following configurations: full-time to full-time, full-time to part-time or part-time to part-time. The customer will be charged for each such connection made at the rates for Other Labor as set forth in Section 13.2.6(C). The rates that apply for the service between each customer designated premises and the Hub are a Central Office Channel Interface, Local Channel, and Interoffice Channel, if applicable. In addition, rates for optional features and functions may be applicable.

7.4.8Shared Use Analog and Digital High Capacity (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA High Capacity) Services

Shared use occurs when Special Access (a.k.a BellSouth SPA) service and BellSouth SWA service are provided over the same High Capacity Special Access facility through a common interface. The Special Access monthly rate for the Local Channel, Interoffice Channel, if applicable Basic Channelization System and Central Office Channel Interface (s) will apply, regardless of whether any individual channels of the shared Special Access (BellSouth SPA) facility are used for Special Access (BellSouth SPA) service, BellSouth SWA service, or any other type of service. The practice known as "ratcheting" (to apply non-Special Access rates on a proportional basis) shall not apply in any circumstance

- (1) Effective November 20, 2019, this Service will no longer be available for purchase by new or existing customers, and service agreements may no longer be renewed. In addition, requests to move, add or change existing service arrangements will not be accepted. Following the expiration of a customer's existing term agreement, service will be provided on a month-to-month basis at the applicable monthly extension rates until the service is discontinued. - (2) Effective November 20, 2019, this Service will no longer be available for purchase by new or existing customers, and service agreements may no longer be renewed. AT&T currently plans to discontinue this Service on or after June 30, 2024.
