**A9.1.5 Billing of Foreign Exchange Service Provided by Multiple Companies**

- A. Each company will bill for the portion of the service provided by their respective service publications based on their terms, conditions, rates and charges as appropriate.
- B. The charges billed by each company for the interoffice channel between exchange telephone company central offices are determined as follows:
  - 1. The total mileage for the service is computed using the V&H coordinates set forth in the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc., Tariff F.C.C. No. 4 (NECA No. 4).
  - 2. A billing factor is determined from the NECA No. 4 tariff. This factor represents the percentage of the distance between exchange telephone company central offices that will be billed by each company. The billing factor is multiplied by the total charge for all of the miles to determine the amount to be billed by the Company.
  - 3. For the fixed recurring rate element and the nonrecurring charge associated with the interoffice channel between exchange telephone company central offices, 50 percent of each company's rate will apply for each end of the interoffice channel provided. If the company does not bill for either end of the interoffice channel, then the fixed recurring charge and nonrecurring charge shall not apply.

**A12.11.1 General**

- A. This Guidebook provides rates and charges applicable to the various facilities utilized by Maritime Mobile and Aviation Radio Telephone Services for connection with the Public Switched Network on a manual basis.
- B. For interconnection of automated systems (requires central office outpulsing arrangement) rates and charges as specified in A12.10.2.A.2., Signaling Arrangement for Radio Common Carriers, will apply.

- Note 1:** The installation charge in A12.7.2.A.1.(a) applies for the establishment of the first group of Non-Consecutive DID numbers where the customer does not currently have DID service. It also applies for the first group of Reserved Numbers or the first Reserved Non-Consecutive DID number where the customer does not currently have DID service or Non-Consecutive DID numbers.
- Note 2:** In addition to the rates and charges for the DID Trunk Termination, rates and charges for DID PBX Trunks or NARs as specified in Section A3 apply as appropriate.
- Note 3:** Combination DID Trunk Terminations with the Call Transfer feature are only provisioned where facilities permit.
- Note 4:** Provides faster signaling on DID PBX trunks or NARs. The choice of pulsing alternative depends on the customer's premises equipment.
- Note 5:** Provides automated referral of calls from a non-listed disconnected DID number to a corresponding new number for twelve months or until the delivery of the new directory, whichever comes first. AIS is available where facilities permit.

- E. Client's and Agency's Responsibilities (Cont'd)
  - 2. Alarm Agency
    - a. Nothing contained in this Guidebook shall be construed as establishing any agency agreement, partnership or joint venture between the Company and any alarm and security company or entity utilizing this service. Any such company or entity utilizing WatchAlert Service shall be responsible for obtaining all licenses, permits and authorizations as may be required by the appropriate federal, state or local governmental authorities and will comply with all codes, laws, terms, conditions, restrictions or limitations governing the use of equipment or services employed by the agency in providing service to its clients.
    - b. Agency requests to connect or disconnect WatchAlert Service must be provided to the Company in writing.
    - c. Client requests to connect or disconnect WatchAlert Service will be to the agency.
    - d. WatchAlert requires the agency to subscribe to two Type 2141 channel services (one for each WSP) between its premises and its serving central office at standard rates and charges as contained in Section B3 of the Private Line Guidebook.
    - e. The agency will be responsible for notifying its clients of any billing changes as described in paragraph D.
    - f. WatchAlert Service will be utilized solely for the transmission of alarm/security signal status. Transmission of other signals or data is prohibited.
- F. Reporting Procedures
  - 1. The agency will, upon receipt of an alarm/security report, contact the client or the client's designated initial point of contact of a potential security problem. The agency will, under no circumstances, have the Company make the first dispatch in response to an alarm/security report at a client's premises. Company dispatch for repair will not be made until verification that the condition is not due to a security problem (burglary, fire). The agency or client must provide safe, personal access for repair service. In the event of an open customer line, the designated Company Repair Service will be the second point of contact.
  - 2. Repair and maintenance of customer premises equipment is not the Company's responsibility. Upon verification by the agency that the terminal equipment is not at fault, the client or agency will report the problem to the designated Company Repair Service. If it is subsequently discovered that the terminal equipment is at fault, the client will be billed the appropriate Dispatch Charge – Trouble Determination (TLCPR) specified for Basic Residence and Basic Business services.
