Descriptive Narrative:	<p>Description of Network Changes Planned: BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida intends to retire copper facilities in distribution area (DAS) 220304 of Green Acres wire center (WPBHFLGA) and due to the impact drainage and sewage project in Village at Palm Springs, Lake Worth, FL.</p> <p>Therefore, AT&T Florida intends to migrate customers to an existing Gigabit Passive Optical Network/Fiber-to-the-Premises (GPON/FTTP) system, where possible, and retire copper cable. FLDOT requested AT&T Florida remove or relocate its facilities in the way of this road project before October 30, 2024.</p> <p>Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes: After implementation of this plan, copper facilities and, consequently, unbundled loops requiring copper facilities, e.g., digital subscriber line (DSL) or line-sharing circuits, will no longer be available in DA 220304.</p> <p>Currently, AT&T Florida records indicate (14) working circuits, and zero are competitive carrier circuits, impacted by this network change. Existing customers will be migrated to GPON/FTTP without consequence.</p>
