Descriptive Narrative:	Description of Network Changes Planned: BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida intends to retire copper facilities in distribution area (DA) 110503 of Lake Worth wire center (WPBHFLLE) and due to FLDOT road project at R 9 I-95 at 10th Ave N.  Therefore, AT&T Florida intends to migrate customers to an existing Gigabit Passive Optical Network/Fiber-to-the-Premises (GPON/FTTP) system, where possible, and retire copper cable. FLDOT requested AT&T Florida remove or relocate its facilities in the way of this road project before October 30, 2024.  Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes: After implementation of this plan, copper facilities and, consequently, unbundled loops requiring copper facilities, e.g., digital subscriber line (DSL) or line-sharing circuits, will no longer be available in DA 110503.  Currently, AT&T Florida records indicate (8) working circuits, and zero are competitive carrier circuits, impacted by this network change. Existing customers will be migrated to GPON/FTTP without consequence.
