Descriptive Narrative:	 Bellsouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida intends to retire copper facilities serving distribution areas (DA) identified in the following wire centers: Brooksville Jefferson (BKVLFLJF), Boynton Beach (BYBHFLMA), Cocoa Main (COCOFLMA), Merritt Island (COCOFLME), Deland Main (DELDFLMA), Ormond Beach (DYBHFLOB), Fernandina Beach (FRBHFLFP), Fort Pierce Main (FTPRFLMA), Gainesville Main (GSVLFLMA), Pembroke Pines (HLWDFLPE), Normandy (JCVFLNO), Keystone Heights Main (KYHGFLMA), Lynn Haven (LYNFLOH), Canal (MIAMIFLCA), Palmetto (MIAMFLPL), Melbourne Main (MLBRFLMA), Lemonwood (MNDRFLLW), New Smyrna Beach (NSBHFLMA), Orlando Pine Castle (ORLDFLPC), Oviedo (OVIDFLCA), Panama City Beach (PCBHFLNT), Panama City Main (PNCYFLMA), St. Augustine Beach Side (STAGFLBS), St. Augustine Main (STAGFLMA), Stuart (STRTFLMA), West Palm Beach Gardens (WPBHFLGR), Haverhill (WPBHFLHH), Weeki Wachee Springs Highlands (WWSPFLHI), Weeki Wachee Springs Spring Hill (WWSPFLSH) and Orlando Sand Lake (ORLDFLSA). Since no customers are currently served by these copper facilities, this action will have no impact on customers. AT&T Florida plans to continue providing service to these DAs over existing Gigabit Passive Optical Network/Fiber-to-the-Fiber Premises (GPON/FTTP) and retire the copper facilities. After implementation of the planned changes, only fiber-based services will be available in these DAs. AT&T Florida records indicate there are no working circuits, including competitive carrier circuits, on the copper facilities in these DAs.
