	BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida intends to retire copper facilities serving distribution area (DA) 421421 in the Brentwood Wire Center (NDADFLBR) in Miami Gardens, FL due to copper cable stolen. On





numerous occasions, thieves have stolen copper cable serving this DA, including their replacement cables. AT&T Florida plans to migrate customers currently served by copper facilities to existing Gigabit Passive Optical Network/Fiber-to-the-Premises (GPON/FTTP) facilities and then retire the copper facilities.
