Descriptive Narrative:	<p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) intends to retire copper feeder facilities serving Distribution Areas (DAs) 435002, 435102, 435202, 435302, 435402, 435502, 435602, 435702, 435802, and 435902 in the Royal Palm Wire Center (WPBHFRLP) in Loxahatchee, FL due to the impact of a planned Florida Department of Transportation (FLDOT) road move construction project along Route 4 SE between Hamlin Blvd and 180th St N in Loxahatchee. FLDOT has requested that AT&T Florida remove or relocate facilities that may be in the path of this project before March 30, 2026.</p> <p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) intends to retire copper feeder and distribution facilities serving Distribution Areas (DAs) 311106 and 311304 in the Palm Beach Annex (WPBHFPLAN) Wire Center in Palm Beach, FL due to a planned Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT/FLDOT) road project associated with the Town of Palm Beach Underground Conversion – Phase 1. This project requires AT&T Florida to remove or relocate facilities in the way of this road move before April 30, 2026.</p> <p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) intends to retire copper feeder and distribution facilities serving Distribution Areas (DAs) 115202, 115401, 115402, 115403, 115502, 115601, 115602, 115604, 115606, 115607, 115801, 115802, 115803, 115805, and 115806 in the Palmetto Wire Center (MIAMFLPL) in Miami, FL. Due to planned construction associated with the Miami-Dade County Roadway and Drainage Improvement project (DB 21-DTPW-04), FDOT has requested that AT&T Florida remove or relocate facilities that may be in the project path before March 30, 2026.</p> <p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) intends to retire copper feeder facilities in Distribution Area (DA) 210705 of the Perrine (PRRNFLMA) Wire Center in Palmetto Bay, FL due to the City of Palmetto Bay Road widening project. The city has requested that AT&T Florida remove or relocate facilities that may be in the way of this project before March 30, 2026.</p>
