# E12. Specialized Service Or Arrangements

#### E12.1 General

#### E12.1.1 Provision of Specialized Service or Arrangements

- Specialized service or arrangements may be provided by the Company, at the request of an IC, on an individual case basis if such service or arrangements meet the following criteria:
  - The requested service or arrangements are not offered under other sections of this Tariff.
  - The facilities utilized to provide the requested service or arrangements are of a type normally used by the Company in furnishing its other services.
  - 3. The requested service or arrangements are provided within a LATA.
  - 4. The requested service or arrangements are compatible with other Company services, facilities, and its engineering and maintenance practices.
  - 5. This offering is subject to the availability of the necessary Company personnel and capital resources.

### **E12.2 Rates and Charges**

Rates and Charges, and additional regulations if applicable, for specialized service or arrangements provided on an individual case basis are filed following:

## **E12.3 Contract Service Arrangements**

(N) E12.3.1 General

- When economically practicable, customer specific contract service arrangements may be furnished in lieu of existing tariff offerings provided there is reasonable potential for uneconomic bypass of the Company's services. Uneconomic bypass occurs when an alternative service arrangement is utilized, in lieu of Company services, at prices below the Company's rates but above the Company's incremental costs.
- Rates, Charges, Terms and additional regulations, if applicable, for the contract service arrangements will be developed on an individual case basis, and will include all relevant costs, plus an appropriate level of contribution.
- (N) Unless otherwise specified, the regulations for contract service arrangements are in addition to the applicable regulations and rates specified in other sections of this Tariff.
