F. Georgia Community Calling (Message Rate/Measured Service)

(Obsoleted 08/25/2001 Type 4 for Residence customers. GCC is not available for new installations or transfers of service to new locations.) (Obsoleted 10/13/2002 Type 4 for Business customers. GCC is not available for new installations or transfers of service to new locations. Business customers may add lines at present locations.)

1. Residence and Business customers who subscribe to Georgia Community Calling (GCC) have an expanded service area included in their local calling area. Calling points within the basic and expanded service areas for GCC are specified in A3.6.1.
2. This offering is limited to where facilities and equipment are available.
3. A message rate charge as specified in A103.7.4.D applies for calls to points within the basic service area. The monthly rate for a GCC exchange access line includes a usage allowance of seventy-five messages for business. Inward only trunks and NARs are excluded from the allowance.¹
4. Residence monthly billed usage charges for calls terminating in the basic service area will not exceed the monthly rate for residence flat rate individual line service at the subscriber's premises.
5. Message rate charges will not apply to calls to the Company Business Office, Repair service, Directory Assistance or for Emergency 911 service. Regular Directory Assistance charges as specified in A3.13 will apply.
6. Usage charges as specified in A103.7.4.D apply for calls to points in the expanded service area and are based on airline mileage between rate centers. The methodology for determining the airline mileage is described in A18.5. (T)
7. Long distance rates as specified in A18.3 apply for calls to points in the expanded service area on which the Company quotes time and charges.
8. All regular *guidebook* charges will apply as appropriate except for those exceptions listed herein. (T)
9. Any combination of message rate and flat rate service will generally not be allowed on the same premises with the exception of GCC customers who subscribe to Deluxe Optional Extended Area Service (OEAS). Additional exceptions are also described in A2.3.2.
10. GCC subscribers are regularly billed monthly in advance. Usage charges, including messages in excess of the monthly allowance, are billed monthly in arrears. Any portion of the monthly message allowance not used in one month may not be credited to the subscriber's account for any other month of service.
11. GCC will not be provided in conjunction with Foreign Exchange or Foreign Central Office Service.
12. Where a subscriber contracts for two or more individual GCC lines on the same premises, and agrees to group billing, the number of monthly message allowances per exchange access line will be multiplied by the number of lines. Messages in excess of this product will be billed at the additional local message charge as specified in A103.7.4. All exchange access lines included for such allowances must have the same central office designation and must be located at the same end user premises. (T)
13. Normal service charges will not apply for one-time conversion from flat rate service to Residential GCC at the same premises. Within six months of the conversion, the Company will restore the customer to flat rate service at no charge if the customer is not satisfied with the service.
14. The compensation rate found in Section E2. of the Access Service Tariff will apply for Interexchange Carriers, Resellers, AOS providers, and all other entities who complete unauthorized intraLATA calls.
15. Operator assisted charges as specified in A3.14.1 apply to operator handled and credit card calls in addition to the usage charges specified.
16. Hotel, Motel and Hospital customers have the option of selecting GCC with the expanded calling area or without the expanded calling area.

B. Terms, Conditions and Limitations of Service

1. The 2 Pack Plan is only available to residence subscribers. A residence subscriber may select any suitable combination of the features/services listed in A103.7.6.A.3, but the customer must select Call Waiting ID and Caller ID. (T)
2. All *terms, conditions* and limitations specified in the sections listed in A103.7.6.A.3 preceding apply to the respective features/services requested as part of this package. (T)
3. All features/services are furnished only from central offices that have been arranged to provide these services. The features/services are provided subject to availability of facilities.
4. Service charges specified in Section A4 do not apply for transactions in which a subscriber only modifies an existing 2 Pack Plan package by adding, deleting or changing features/services requested as part of the package.
5. Existing customers of the 2 Pack Plan can not take advantage of special promotions for the 2 Pack Plan or any of the features/services specified in A103.7.6.A.3, unless specifically allowed by the terms of the special promotion.
6. The 2 Pack Plan can be suspended as specified in A2.3.16. During the period of suspension, the rate specified following applies.

A103.11 Optional Extended Area Service

(Obsoleted October 13, 2002, Type 4. Optional Extended Area Service is not available for new installations or transfers of service to new locations. Current subscribers may add lines at their present locations.)

A103.11.1 General

- A.** Optional Extended Area Service (OEAS) provides alternative billing for customer dialed station-to-station calls to or from locations outside a subscriber's local calling area but within the same LATA for the exchanges specified in A103.11.2. OEAS rates and charges apply only for calls to locations outside a subscriber's local calling area. OEAS is available in the following configurations:
1. **Economy** - This option provides for measured calling from the subscriber's location to one or more exchanges outside the subscriber's local calling area but within the same LATA. Monthly usage is billed at bulk rates subject to conditions specified in A103.11.1.I. following.
 2. **Discount** - This option provides for measured calling from the subscriber's location to one or more exchanges outside the subscriber's local calling area but within the same LATA. Monthly usage is billed at the rates specified in A103.11.2.C.1. following.¹ Customers pay a fixed monthly charge as specified in A103.11.2.C. following to subscribe to this service.
 3. **Deluxe** - This option permits a subscriber to make unlimited free outgoing calls from the subscriber's location to one or more exchanges outside the subscriber's local calling area but within the same LATA. Customers pay a fixed monthly charge per access line as specified in A103.11.2.C. following to subscribe to this service. This option is available only to residence customers as specified in B. following.
 4. **Incoming Discount** - This option permits a subscriber to pay for customer-dialed, station-to-station calls received at the subscriber's location and placed from one or more specified exchanges outside the subscriber's local calling area but within the same LATA. Monthly incoming usage covered by this option is billed at the rates specified in A103.11.2.C.1. following.¹ Customers pay a fixed monthly charge as specified in A103.11.2.C. following to subscribe to this service.
- B.** These services are offered in the exchanges specified in A103.11.2 following subject to the availability of facilities and billing capabilities. These services are available to all business and residence subscribers except as specified herein. Customers who subscribe to four-party service, Public Telephone Access Service, Sharing and Resale of Basic Local Exchange Service, or lines which terminate in hotels, motels, nursing homes or hospitals to serve guests or patients may not subscribe to this service. OEAS is not available to users of Dormitory Communications Service. All business customers and any residence customers who subscribe to two-party service may not subscribe to Deluxe OEAS.
- C.** OEAS is intended for the personal use or business use of the subscriber and may not be resold to others or used on a planned and continuing basis to intentionally avoid the payment in whole or in part of message toll charges by others.
- D.** The minimum service period is one month.
- E.** Suspension of OEAS is allowed subject to the terms and conditions specified in A2.3.16. During the suspension period, the monthly recurring rates for the service are rated at one-half their normal amounts. (T)
- F.** Service Charges will not apply for a conversion from basic flat rate service to OEAS or vice versa.
- G.** The rates for OEAS are in addition to rates for exchange service.
- H.** If a customer subscribes to an OEAS option, the option must apply to every line, trunk or NAR on the customer's account.
- I.** For Economy OEAS the following *terms and conditions* also apply: (T)
1. A minimum monthly charge equivalent to one hour for business and one-half hour for residence is applicable for each account which may be one line or a group billed multi-line system. All eligible lines for which message tolls are group billed may use the service, providing they are within the same exchange; however, there can be no mixing of classes of service between residence and business.
 2. The usage, in minutes, for messages originated before 8:00 a.m. or after 5:00 p.m. on weekdays or on a Saturday, Sunday or holidays will be discounted at the prevailing Long Distance Message Telecommunications Service discount rates except as provided in the following:
 3. OEAS calling for one-way service is not in effect for messages originated from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. or from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on weekdays except weekday holidays as specified in Section A18. Messages originated during these hours will be billed at the prevailing Long Distance rates. (T)

Note 1: The usage schedule becomes effective March 1, 1991. Prior to March 1, 1991, OEAS usage between rate centers greater than 22 miles apart will be billed at a fifty percent discount from the prevailing long distance rates as specified in A18.3.1.H. Other OEAS usage will be billed at the prevailing long distance rates.

- A. Back-Up Line is an optional service which provides individual line business subscribers with an additional line for inward and outward calling.
- B. This service is only available to individual line business subscribers where facilities permit. Back-Up Line service cannot be used as the primary business line and must be located on the same premises as the associated business individual line.
- C. Each Back-Up Line can receive calls forwarded from one busy primary line or hunt group at no charge. This overflow capability will be provided on the forwarding line.

If a customer subscribes to more than one Back-Up Line, these Back-Up Lines may be provisioned in an overflow group at no charge. Overflow capability may not be provided from a Back-Up Line or group of Back-Up Lines to other lines on the same premises.

- D. Overflow capability from additional primary lines or hunt groups to Back-Up Line service will be provided on the forwarding line.

A103.41.1 General

- A. Complete Choice service provides the features specified following and an exchange service access line. The line includes Touch-Tone capability.
- B. The rates specified herein entitle a residence subscriber to unlimited calling to all exchange access lines within the basic local service area specified in A3.6.
- C. The rates specified herein also entitle a residence subscriber to unlimited use of the services/features specified in the following sections:
 - A13.9 Custom Calling Services
 - A13.19 TouchStar service excluding Calling Number Delivery Blocking-Permanent
 - A13.20 Customized Code Restriction
 - A13.34 RingMaster service
 - A13.47 Message Waiting Indication
 - A113.10 Obsolete Custom Calling Services
 - A12.16.2.A Call Hold and Call Pickup only (PCS limitations do not apply)

A subscriber may select an unlimited number of compatible services or features from the sections listed above. All *terms, conditions* and limitations specified in the sections listed (except as indicated above) apply to the respective services/features requested as part of this service. Service charges specified in Section A4. do not apply for transactions involving only additions, deletions or changes to the services or features requested as part of this service. (T)

- D. Residence customers may subscribe to the Two-Line Plan or the Three-Line Plan for Complete Choice service. Both plans offer rotary line service as specified in A2.3.4 at no additional charge in addition to the features listed in C. All services/features specified as available with Complete Choice service are available with each line of a multi-line package. All lines in each multi-line package must be billed to the same account and located at the same premises.
- E. Service charges specified in Section A4. of do not apply for conversion of existing service to/from Complete Choice service.
- F. Existing customers of Complete Choice service may not take advantage of any special promotion for Complete Choice service or Area Plus service with the Complete Choice option or any of the services or features specified in C., unless specifically allowed by the terms of the special promotion.

A103.43.1 Plan Descriptions

A. BellSouth Business Plus Service

1. BellSouth Business Plus service is offered as a business individual line service where facilities and equipment are available.
2. BellSouth Business Plus service allows the business customer to choose between two LATA-wide¹ calling options:
 - a. Option 1 - Flat rated plan which allows for unlimited calling within the LATA (subject to a total usage allowance of 120 hours/7,200 minutes).
 - b. Option 2 - Combination rated plan which provides for unlimited usage within the basic service area for a flat monthly charge, and a single rate for each minute of use for all other calling within the LATA.
3. The option chosen by the BellSouth Business Plus service subscribers will apply to each of their lines.
4. Touch-Tone Calling service is provided to all BellSouth Business Plus service subscribers at no additional charge.
5. Customers may subscribe to either the standalone BellSouth Business Plus service offering or to the BellSouth Business Choice Package (See A103.44) which includes a BellSouth Business Plus service line or to the BellSouth Complete Choice for Business package (See A3.45) which includes a BellSouth Business Plus service line. If BellSouth Business Plus service is subscribed to, the rates of A103.43.2 are applicable. If BellSouth Business Choice Package or Complete Choice for Business package is subscribed to, the rates of A103.44.2 or A3.45.2, respectively, are applicable. All of the **terms, conditions** and limitations specified for each offering will apply to the respective services and features. (T)
6. Usage rating is dependent upon the underlying service of the originating call location. When BellSouth Business Plus service usage charges as described in 2. preceding are applicable, they will also apply to 1+, 0+ and 0- calls made within the LATA. However, for 0+ and 0- calls, usage does not contribute toward the Option 1 usage threshold and each minute of use is rated. The appropriate operator services surcharges will also be charged in accordance with the **terms and conditions** of A.3.14. (T)
7. BellSouth Business Plus service Option 2 customers only may subscribe to Local Usage Detail for billable usage. There is no charge for the Local Usage Detail.
8. Method of Determining Monthly Usage Charges
 - a. Usage is determined for each call based on minutes or fraction thereof, with minimum call duration of one minute. This value is then multiplied by the rate per minute for the rate option selected by the customer. The resultant amount is truncated to whole cents for each call. The amount of usage billed to the customer is subject to b. and c. following.
 - b. For Option 1, only usage above the first 120 hours (7,200 minutes) of usage allowance is billed to the customer.
 - c. For Option 2, only usage outside the Basic Service Area is subject to the billing as described in a. preceding.

- A. BellSouth Business Choice Packages are offered where facilities and equipment are available.
- B. BellSouth Business Choice Packages are offered to business subscribers and consists of a BellSouth Business Plus service Calling Plan line, touch-tone service and a choice of up to five selected calling features per line. BellSouth Business Choice Packages are available only in conjunction with BellSouth Business Plus service Calling Plan Options 1 and 2 as described in A3.43. The calling feature choices are listed in D. following.
- C. The BellSouth Business Plus service Calling Plan option chosen by the subscriber will apply to each line on the same account. BellSouth Business Plus options may not be mixed on the same account.
- D. For each line, the BellSouth Business Choice Package also provides the subscriber with up to five compatible services and features from the following list. All of the *terms, conditions* and limitations specified in Section A13. apply to the respective services and features requested as part of this service. The calling features chosen may vary from line to line in a BellSouth Business Choice Package line grouping. (T)
