## R2. GENERAL REGULATIONS

### R2.1 Application

The regulations specified herein are applicable for the resale of services offered in this Tariff by certificated Other Local Exchange Companies (OLECs). Additional regulations, where applicable, pertaining to specific service offerings accompany such offerings as provided in the Company's General Exchange Guidebook located at [www.att.com/guidebook](http://www.att.com/guidebook).

The Company may discontinue certain Company services in geographic areas for which the Company has no customers subscribing to those services.

### R2.2 Limitations and Use of Resold Services

#### R2.2.1 General

- A. Unless specific exceptions are made to the contrary elsewhere in this Tariff, OLECs may resell those services identified in R2.3 following, subject to the same terms and conditions under which those services are available for sale to end users or other customers as set forth in the Company's General Exchange Guidebook, as well as pursuant to the terms, conditions, and limitations specific to Resellers as set forth in this Tariff.
- B. The provision of such services by the Company as set forth in this Tariff does not constitute a joint undertaking with the OLEC for the furnishing of any service.
- C. The Reseller will be the customer of record for all resold services. Except as specified in R2.2.7.F. of this Tariff, the Company will take orders from, bill and expect payment from the Reseller for all resold services.
- D. The Reseller will be the Company's single point of contact for all services available for resale as provided for in this tariff.
- E. The Company will continue to bill the end user for any services that the end user specifies it wishes to receive directly from the Company.
- F. The Company maintains the right to serve directly any end user within an identified resale service area. The Company will continue to directly market its own local exchange and private line products and services and in doing so may establish independent relationships with end users of OLECs.
- G. An OLEC must not interfere with the right of any person or entity to obtain service directly from the Company.
- H. In most circumstances, the current telephone number may be retained by the end user regardless of who provides the local service.
- I. Telephone numbers are assigned by the Company to the service furnished. The Reseller has no right to the telephone number or any other call number designation by the Company associated with services furnished by the Company, and no right to the continuance of service through any particular central office. The Company reserves the right to change such numbers, or the central office designation associated with such numbers, or both, whenever the Company deems it necessary to do so in the conduct of its business.
- J. The Company may provide any service or facility for which a charge is not established herein, as long as it is offered on the same terms to all Resellers for a charge not less than the Company's cost.
- K. The Company will also bill the Reseller End User Common Line (EUCL) charges as set forth in BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., Tariff FCC. No. 1, Section 4.7.

#### R2.2.2 Unlawful Use of Service

- A. Service is furnished subject to the condition that it will not be used for any unlawful purpose.
- B. Service will be discontinued if any law enforcement agency advises that the service being used is in violation of the law.
- C. The Company can refuse service when it has grounds to believe that service will be in violation of the law.
- D. The Company accepts no responsibility to any person for any unlawful act committed by a Reseller as part of providing service to the Reseller's customers.
- E. The Company will cooperate fully with law enforcement agencies with subpoenas and court orders for assistance with the Company's customers. Law enforcement agency subpoenas and court orders for assistance for customers that are not the Company's end users will be directed to the Reseller. The Company will bill the Reseller for implementing any requests by law enforcement agencies on the Reseller's end users.
