If dialing does not commence within the time delay period, a predetermined telephone number is automatically dialed. The predetermined telephone number and time delay period are selected by the **customer** at the time service is established and can be changed only via service order.
- В. Warm Line Service may be used only in connection with individual line service.
- C. Warm Line Service is furnished only from central offices which have been arranged to provide this service and is provided subject to the availability of facilities.
