- 1.3 Pursuant to Sections 13-501 and 13-502 of the Public Utilities Act (PUA), the Telephone Company hereby states that the services contained in this tariff, with the exception Section 16, are for present purposes classified as "noncompetitive" services, without prejudice to any subsequent classification or reclassification.
