A9. FOREIGN EXCHANGE SERVICE AND FOREIGN CENTRAL OFFICE SERVICE

A9.1 Foreign Exchange Service

A9.1.1 *Terms and Conditions*

- A. Foreign Exchange Service is exchange service furnished to a subscriber from an exchange other than the one from which he would normally be served.
- B. Foreign Exchange Service is offered in connection with Flat or Measured Rate Individual Main Station Line Service, Flat or Measured Rate PBX Service, Network Access Service and Centrex Type Services only. These channels may also be furnished on a link (partial channel) basis when connected to FlexServ service, LightGate service, MegaLink channel service, or MegaLink ISDN service. Combination of Flat and Measured Rate Foreign Exchange Service will not be furnished from the same exchange on the same premises to the same subscriber or to a group of different subscribers. Foreign Exchange Service is not provided in connection with Joint User Service.
- C. Other services, equipment or facilities used in connection with Foreign Exchange Service, except as otherwise indicated in this *Guidebook*, are furnished subject to the rates, *terms and conditions* applying in the foreign exchange from which the subscriber is served. (T)
- D. Foreign Exchange Service is furnished subject to the same restrictions as to the use of the service by other than the subscriber and his representatives, as apply in connection with other classes of service.
- E. Subscribers to Foreign Exchange Service are not required to subscribe to other service in the exchange from which they would normally be served except where the normal exchange has Extended Area Service with the foreign exchange.
- F. Where the serving foreign exchange is a multi-office exchange, Foreign Exchange Service will be provided from whichever central office would be most economical to the Company; if an applicant desires operation from a different central office and facilities are available therefore, foreign central office mileage charges will apply for the channel required between the Company-selected central office and the central office from which the applicant desires to be served.
- G. Rate mileage for Foreign Exchange Service to an Extended Area Service group of exchanges will always be measured to the Rate Center of the Principal Exchange of that group. However, if the applicant insists on having a telephone number of an exchange in this group other than the Principal Exchange, such may be provided subject to the availability of facilities. If additional interexchange facilities are required to extend the service from the Principal Exchange to the requested exchange, an additional mileage charge for the airline distance between these exchanges will be applicable. The Principal Exchanges of the Company having Extended Area Service are indicated in A3.4.
- H. When a Foreign Exchange Service is served from an exchange that does not have two-way traffic sensitive measuring capabilities, the flat rate banding charge as specified in A9.1.3.O.1.d. following applies. The flat rate banding charge will be converted to the minutes of use banding as specified in A9.1.3.O.1.e. following when the serving exchange has the capability of two-way traffic sensitive measurement. Those customers affected will be notified at least 30 days prior to the conversion.

A9.1.3 Rates And Charges (Cont'd)

H. Where the applicant for Foreign Exchange Service is so located that in the judgment of the Company it would be both technically and economically practical, Foreign Exchange Service may be provided directly from the foreign exchange wire center to the applicant's location by the extension or utilization of existing plant. Construction charges, as specified in Section A5.1., will apply where an extension of existing plant is required. Mileage charges for direct served Foreign Exchange Service will apply as follows in addition to the appropriate usage charge, if applicable. (T)

For the airline distance from the applicant's location to the serving wire center of the Foreign Exchange area where direct service is to be furnished, the mileage charge as specified in O. following will apply. If the provisioning of channel terminals for direct served Foreign Exchange Service is not required, the First mile Monthly rate does not apply and the following Installation Charges apply per channel in lieu of those as shown in O. These charges are applicable per customer request as defined in A4.1.:

I. Foreign Exchange Service may be furnished involving two areas of the Company or involving an area of the Company and an area of a connecting company when the connecting company is willing to concur in arrangements for furnishing such service. Where the connecting company concurs in the interexchange rates, *terms and conditions* of this Company in A9.1.1. preceding, the mileage measurement and mileage charges will be as indicated in O. following. (T)

J. Where Foreign Exchange Service is furnished involving the following concurring connecting companies and this Company, only the usage/interconnect charge applicable in the serving Wire Center of the foreign exchange area applies. The usage/interconnect charge of the company terminating the Foreign Exchange Service at the customer's location will not apply. The following are the connecting companies:

K. When reversible channels are furnished exchange service connections are provided at both points, but only one such connection can be established at a time. Reversible operation is controlled by the customer at will.

L. FX service in those exchanges that do not have two-way traffic sensitive measuring capabilities will be rated from the flat rate banding schedule. FX service in those exchanges that do have two-way traffic sensitive measuring capabilities will be rated from the minutes of use banding schedule using cumulative minutes of use in each billing period.

M. Both the flat rate banding schedule and the minutes of use banding schedule will be based upon mileage as determined in A9.1.1.G. and A9.1.3.B. preceding.

N. All calls utilizing Foreign Exchange Service that terminate outside the Local Calling Area will be billed as measured toll service or Expanded Local Calling Area service in addition to the appropriate banding schedule rate.

A9. FOREIGN EXCHANGE SERVICE AND FOREIGN CENTRAL OFFICE SERVICE

A9.2 Foreign Central Office Service

A9.2.1 General

- A. Foreign Central Office Service is exchange service furnished to a subscriber in a multi-office exchange from a central office other than the one from which service would normally be furnished.
- B. Foreign Central Office Service is offered in connection with Individual Line Main Station Service, PBX Service and Centrex Type Services only.
- C. Other services, equipment or facilities used in connection with Foreign Central Office Service, except as otherwise indicated in this Guidebook, are furnished subject to the rates, *terms and conditions* applying in the foreign central office from which the subscriber is served. (T)
- D. Alternate routing of this service may be provided on a direct serve basis to the subscriber's premises from the requested foreign central office on an individual case basis as specified in Section A5, subject to the following conditions:
 - 1. The subscriber must maintain a minimum of fifty percent of the trunks/lines from the central office from which service would normally be furnished.
 - 2. Rates and charges for all components of the service will continue to apply as specified in A9.2.2.A. and B, with the exception of those applicable for Type 2145 channel(s). The monthly rate for the class of service desired will be based on the rates applicable from the foreign central office, but will be no less than the rates for that service from the subscriber's normal serving wire center. Additionally, rates and charges as specified in A5 will apply on an individual case basis.

A9.2.2 Rates And Charges

A. Methods Of Applying Rates

The rate for Foreign Central Office Service is the monthly rate for the class of service desired, plus a foreign central office mileage charge as shown in A9.2.2 for the distance, airline measurement, between the central office from which the subscriber would normally be served and the foreign central office (i.e., the central office from which the subscriber desires to be served). In addition the subscriber is charged any Zone Charges which would apply for connection with the central office from which service would be rendered.
