Peak period rates apply from 8 AM to 8 PM, Monday through Friday (excluding holidays). Off-peak period rates apply to all other times and are rated at a 50 percent discount.

All calls completed within the Expanded Local Calling Area as described in Section A1. will be billed according to the rates, terms and conditions as specified in A3.32 or A3.33.

- D. Usage charges may be billed to numbers other than the Measured Service telephone number.
- E. Usage charges apply to local calls completed with operator assistance in addition to Operator Assisted Local Call Surcharges, when applicable. Such calls are itemized on the subscriber's billing statement and are billed outside any applicable usage allowances for dialed sent paid calls.
- F. Where Local Optional Service Option B is available, Local Optional Service is not available to Measured service subscribers.

- b. Calls completed with operator assistance within the local calling area described in A3.6, will have usage charges and appropriate Operator Assisted Local Call surcharges applied (when applicable). Such calls are itemized on the subscriber's billing statement. (M1)
- c. Usage charges, only for calls completed within the local calling area described in A3.6, may be billed to numbers other than the Expanded Local Area Calling telephone. (M1)
- 2. Expanded Local Area Calling includes unlimited usage for calls terminating within Band 0. All other local calls are billed in accordance with the usage schedule in A103.10.C.3, following. Local usage charges will not exceed \$1.50 per residence line. The individual access line and unlimited Band 0 usage are provided at the following rate. (M1)

- 4. Time/Day Discount - The preceding usage rates are peak period rates and apply from 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M., Monday through Friday (excluding holidays, as specified in A3.2.3). Off-peak period rates apply to all other times and are rated at a 50 percent discount. When messages span more than one rate period, total charges for the minutes in each rate period are summarized and the results for each period are totaled to obtain the total message charge. (M1)
- 5. All calls completed beyond the calling area of this plan but within the Expanded Local Calling Area as described in Section A1. will be billed according to the rates, terms and conditions as specified in A3.32 or A3.33. (M1)

A103.44.1 General

- A. BellSouth Business Choice packages are offered where facilities and equipment are available.
- B. BellSouth Business Choice packages are offered to business subscribers and consists of a BellSouth Business Plus service line, touch-tone service and a choice of up to five selected calling features per line. BellSouth Business Choice packages are available only in conjunction with BellSouth Business Plus service Options 1 and 2 as described in A3.43. The calling feature choices are listed in D. following.
- C. The BellSouth Business Plus service option chosen by the subscriber will apply to each line on the same account. BellSouth Business Plus service options may not be mixed on the same account.
- D. For each line, the BellSouth Business Choice package also provides the subscriber with up to five compatible services and features from the following list. All of the terms, conditions and limitations specified in Section A13. apply to the respective services and features requested as part of this service. The calling features chosen may vary from line to line in a BellSouth Business Choice package line grouping.

A103.44.3 Service Charges

- A. The service order charges specified in Section A4. are applicable for the installations of new lines at the subscriber's premises. These charges are not applicable for existing customers who wish to move from an existing line to a BellSouth Business Plus service Calling Plan or a BellSouth Business Choice Package.
- B. Service charges do not apply for transactions which only involve additions, deletions or changes to the service or features requested as part of BellSouth Business Plus service with BellSouth Business Choice Package service.

A103.44.4 Multi-Package Discount Plan

- A. The Multi-Package Discount Plan provides eligible BellSouth Business Choice Package customers reduced monthly package rates based upon the number of BellSouth Business Choice Packages subscribed to.
- B. Eligibility for the discounts is based upon the following parameters:
 - 1. A minimum purchase of two BellSouth Business Choice Packages is required.
 - 2. The BellSouth Business Choice Packages must be provisioned to a single customer at a single location.
 - 3. Only the lines at the customer location that are in a hunting arrangement are eligible. The number of Discount Eligible Packages equals the number of lines in hunt.
- C. Discounts range from \$4.00 to \$64.00 depending upon the number of Discount Eligible Packages.
