### E2.7 Special Promotions

#### E2.7.1 Regulations

- A. The Company may offer special promotions of new or existing services or products upon 10 days notice to the Commission. These promotions are temporary waivers of certain recurring and/or nonrecurring charges or one-time credits to customers' accounts. Subject to the availability of services and facilities, promotions are offered on a completely nondiscriminatory basis with each subscriber in the classification of service and area for which the promotion is offered having an equal opportunity for participation. In the event that a promotion occurs during any other scheduled promotion, the customer may choose only one of the available promotions in which to participate. Notification will include the time period in which the promotion will be conducted as well as the terms and conditions.
