When the number of main stations within the Basic Local Calling A rea of an exchange increases to the extent of exceeding, for four (4) consecutive month-end counts, the upper limit of the group under which billing has been made, or decreases to the extent of being less, for four (4) consecutive month-end counts, than the lower limit of the group under which billing has been made, the Company shall file, in accordance with the statutory provisions and Rules and Regulations of the Commission, a revised local exchange guidebook, to be effective with billing dates beginning two (2) months after the fourth (4th) month-end count, reclassifying that exchange to the appropriate group; provided, however, that when an exchange has been reclassified solely because of grow thin the number of main stations within the existing local calling area, such exchange shall not be reclassified again for the next 24 months solely because of further grow thwith in the Basic Local Calling A rea.
