SERVICE LINE SERVICE^{/1/}**A. Standard Arrangement**

Service lines may be connected with the Company's facilities in a central office through circuits provided by the Company at a rate of \$1.10 per month, per line.

B. General Regulations

1. The primary service area for service lines connected to a central office is the same as that for customers within the exchange in which the service lines are located. Service lines may be connected with only one central office and may not be extended across exchange area boundaries.
2. Contracts are executed with an agent representing all service line customers on the line, and the agent is responsible for the payment in full of all charges to the account. Contracts are executed with the agent for a period of one year, terminable thereafter upon 30-days written notice. All charges are payable in advance, except toll charges which are payable monthly in arrears.
3. Under the service line rates shown in Paragraph A., the Company provides pole leads and circuits from the central office to a junction point at or near the initial rate area boundary. Beyond this junction point, customers are required to furnish and maintain the pole lead or both, as the case may be.
4. Customer's lines, instruments and apparatus must be constructed, maintained and operated so as to insure satisfactory service or connection will not be permitted.

Failure to provide satisfactorily for the proper maintenance shall be considered a voluntary termination of the contract by the customer (agent).

5. Extension Service is not furnished in connection with Service Line Service.

C. Service Lines Connected With a Central Office

1. The rate for service lines specified in Paragraph A. applies when five or more customers are connected to the line and entitles customers to switching service and to one listing for each main telephone.
2. If there are less than five customers connected to the line, the rate for a residence customer is the rate for five residence customers divided by the number of total customers connected to the line. The rate per residence customer shall not exceed the residence rate for Exchange Service for a corresponding class of service within the base rate area.
