#### A. Blytheville, Arkansas Exchange

##### 1. General

This Guidebook is governed, except as otherwise specified herein, by all other Tariffs of the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company on file in the State of Missouri, which are hereby made a part of this Guidebook. Unless otherwise specified, the charges quoted in this Guidebook or in any other Missouri Tariff or Guidebook are for periods of one month, are payable monthly in advance and entitle the customer to exchange telephone service within the Blytheville Exchange Area and Extended Area Service to the Dell, Arkansas, Exchange.

This exchange area includes, in addition in the Missouri portion, certain territory in the State of Arkansas comprising the City of Blytheville and vicinity, as shown on the exchange area map for this exchange.

##### 2. Rates

**HUNTING LINE SERVICES****A. General**

These services are available to one-party customers where facilities exist:

*Rotary Hunt:* The hunt for an idle line starts with the called line in a prearranged group and ends with the last line in the group, completing the call to the first idle line encountered. Unless the first line is called, only a portion of the group is hunted.

*Circle Hunt:* This feature permits a complete hunt sequence over all the lines in a prearranged group. If no idle line is encountered, the hunt will continue until it reaches the line that was originally called.

**HOTLINE/WARMLINE<sup>/1/ /4/</sup>****A. Description of Service<sup>/2/</sup>**

1. The Hotline feature provides an access line with the capability to automatically originate a call to a preassigned number. The call is immediately and automatically triggered by an off-hook condition. Incoming calls will be received normally.
2. The Warmline feature provides an access line with the capability to automatically originate a call to a preassigned number. The call is triggered by an off-hook condition, but only after a five-second waiting period. During the five-second waiting period, the customer may manually dial an outgoing call. Incoming calls will be received normally.
