A3. BASIC LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

A3.26 Network Access Service

A3.26.1 General

- A. Network access may be provided on a volume usage measured rate basis for those customers subscribing to LightGate service, MegaLink channel service *or* CNM - FlexServ service. The charges following in A3.26.2 are applicable only on those lines, trunks, or Network Access Registers (NAR) provided for local network access. (C)
- B. When the facility portion of an ESSX service main station line is provided on LightGate service, MegaLink channel service or CNM - FlexServ service, network access will be provided at the following charges for ESSX service NAR Volume Usage Measured Rate Service. These rates replace those described in A3.12.
- C. Foreign Exchange Service, when provided for use with LightGate service, MegaLink channel service *or* CNM - FlexServ service, will be furnished on a volume usage basis and billed the volume usage measured rate following. (C)
- D. The following usage terms and conditions will apply for all dialed sent paid local calls for each line, trunk, or NAR provided for local network access.
 - 1. Usage charges will be billed at the applicable usage schedule rates for measured rate service, Area Calling Plan, or the Enhanced Area Calling Plan Trial, as appropriate.
 - 2. Summarized total usage charges will be reduced by 50 percent prior to the application of the usage allowance. Time/Day discounts do not apply.
 - 3. A usage allowance of \$20.00 per line, trunk, or NAR is applicable.
 - 4. Total billed usage charges will not exceed \$20.00 per line, trunk or NAR. This term and condition does not apply to resold services.
 - 5. Allowances and caps apply to calls terminating in Bands A, B and C for Area Calling Plan subscribers and Bands A, B, C and D for Enhanced Area Calling Plan Trial Subscribers.
- E. Local calls completed within the local calling area described in A3.6.1 that are not dialed sent paid, i.e., operator assisted, etc., will be billed individually at the same usage rates specified in D.1. preceding (including Time/Day usage provisions), in addition to any applicable Operator Assisted Local Call surcharges. Such calls are itemized on the subscriber's billing statement and are billed outside any applicable calling allowance, caps, or usage billing reductions for dialed sent paid local calls.

Non-sent paid calls outside of the local calling area described in A3.6.1. are charged at the established long distance and operator surcharge rates.
- F. When individual lines or trunks are provided in addition to LightGate service, MegaLink channel service *or* CNM - FlexServ service, they are provided at the rates stated in A3.26.2.C., F. and I. following. These rates include the usage allowance referenced in D.3. preceding and an exchange access line. All other terms and conditions stated in A3.26.1.D. are applicable. Volume Usage Measured Rate Service on LightGate service, MegaLink channel service *or* CNM - FlexServ service cannot be mixed with any other measured or flat rate local exchange service. (C)
- G. All terms and conditions that appear in other sections of this Guidebook apply unless otherwise stated herein.

A. (Cont'd)

5. Upon expiration of the CSPP, if customer has not entered into a new CSPP contract (per Private Line Guidebook, Paragraph B2.4.9.A.7.a.(1)), or term extension (per Paragraph 4.):
 - for customer contracts expiring prior to December 1, 2017, continue service at the Month-to-Month price then currently in effect for the Month-to-Month Payment Plan, or
 - for customer contracts expiring on or after December 1, 2017, continue service at the Monthly Extension rates in effect at the time the CSPP contract expires until the customer cancels or renews the service with a new CSPP contract. Subsequently, customers under the Monthly Extension rates may convert their existing service to either a 12- 24-or 36-month CSPP at the then current rates. The customer will not be assessed any associated nonrecurring charges as long as the physical serving arrangement does not change.

Monthly Extension rates are equal to one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the customer's expiring contractual rate.;

6. If Customer migrates a Primary Rate ISDN service or service component (the "Terminated ILEC Service") to a qualifying AT&T Business Voice over IP (BVoIP) Service, then AT&T will waive the Termination Liability Charge associated with the Terminated ILEC Service if:
 - a. the Terminated ILEC Service has been installed at the Customer site for no fewer than 12 months, and
 - b. the replacement AT&T BVoIP Service is installed or available at the same Customer sites as the Terminated ILEC Service.

It is at the Company's sole determination whether a product change satisfies these requirements.

- B. Nonrecurring charges associated with the Primary Rate ISDN Access Line or Interoffice Channel facilities will not be applicable when upgrading from an existing MegaLink service to Primary Rate ISDN. A Type 1 Service Change Charge as specified in A42.3.4.G. will be applicable for the MegaLink service upgrade in addition to nonrecurring charges for other Primary Rate ISDN rate elements ordered.
- C. No nonrecurring charges will be applicable when converting from one Primary Rate ISDN option to another, e.g. Voice/Data to Inward Data or Inward Data to Inward Data Extended Reach Service (ERS). The term "conversion" means that the Primary Rate Interface(s) remain in place in the same central office. If the Primary Rate Interface(s) are moved in connection with ERS, the change is considered a rearrangement and terms and conditions stated in D. following are applicable. No termination charges are applicable for conversions when:
 1. The contract selected for the new Primary Rate ISDN arrangement is coterminous with the previous contract or is for a 24 month period, whichever is longer, and,
 2. the service orders to disconnect the previous arrangement and to install the new Primary Rate ISDN arrangement are related together and received by the Company at the same time with no lapse in billing of service.

3. Cancellation charges will only apply to subscribers under the Term Payment Plan.

5. Cancellation charges will be applied where service provided under a Term Payment Plan is removed prior to the expiration of the subscribers Term Payment Plan.
6. The customer who elects to disconnect their Digital ESSX service prior to the end of their Term Payment Plan period will pay the lower of the Cancellation or Termination Liability charge. 2. Variable Term Payment Plan Option

J. Moves of Service

1. A move of a customer's ESSX Service to a location served by different central office switching equipment will be considered a termination of service at the existing location and the establishment of new service at the proposed location.
2. When a customer's ESSX Service is relocated from one location to another within an area served by a single central office switch, only the customer's exchange circuits will be treated as stated in A112.32.6.J.1. Main station line installation charges will apply to all main station lines relocated.

B2.1.6 Work Performed Outside Regular Working Hours

The rates and charges specified in this Guidebook contemplate that work will be performed during regular working hours and that work once begun will not be interrupted by the customer. If, at the request of the customer, work is performed outside of regular working hours, either to meet his convenience or because the time allowed is insufficient to permit completion during regular hours or if the customer interrupts work which has begun, the customer may be required to pay any additional costs incurred.

B2.1.9 Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP) System

A. Service Description

1. The Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP) System is a structured coding scheme that prescribes the order in which National Security Emergency Preparedness (NSEP) telecommunications services are installed or restored. The TSP System was developed to support the requirements of the U. S. Government and applies only to NSEP telecommunications services to which the Company is able to apply priority treatment. It requires and authorizes priority action by the Company.
2. Conditions of emergency or crises that cause invocation of NSEP treatment can only be declared by authorized officials of the Federal Government or other officials (Federal or non-Federal) specified by the Director, Office of Emergency Communications (OEC) on behalf of the Executive Office of the President of the United States.

B. Service Limitations

1. Priority installation and/or restoration of NSEP telecommunications services shall be provided in accordance with Part 64.401, Appendix A, of the Federal Communications Commission's Rules and Regulations.

A. Channel Services Payment Plan (Cont'd)

3. Additions

- a. Additions of services or rate elements for activating spare or unused capacities of a service under a CSPP arrangement will be considered part of the existing CSPP arrangement.
- b. Additions of services or rate elements, i.e. new local channels, interoffice channels, etc., other than for activating spare or unused capacities, must be under a new CSPP arrangement at rates and charges as specified in 2. preceding.
- c. Termination charges for premature disconnection of added contractual services will apply as set forth under Disconnects as stated in 4. following.
- d. Additions under CSPP are exempt from Company-initiated rate changes for all payment periods longer than one month. However, decreases for any rate element will automatically flow through to the customer.
- e. Installation, service order, service establishment, and any other nonrecurring charges, as specified in this Guidebook, will apply to the added channel services.
- f. Additions of SMARTRing service rate elements must be ordered as described in B7.7

4. Disconnects

- a. When a service or rate element, included under a CSPP arrangement, is disconnected prior to expiration of the selected service period, termination liability charges apply as set forth in the rate terms and conditions in this Guidebook for such service. Remaining services or rate elements will not be affected by such disconnections.
- b. When a service under a CSPP arrangement is disconnected prior to the expiration of a selected service period as a result of a change of jurisdiction and/or a customer requested change to a higher order of a separately available service, termination liability charges will not apply when:
 - the completed service period is twelve months, or twenty-five percent of the length of the originally selected CSPP service period, whichever is greater, and
 - the service period of the new CSPP arrangement for the higher order of service is a minimum twenty-four month service period or equals/exceeds the remaining service period of the disconnected arrangement, whichever is greater, and
 - the service orders to install the new higher order of service and disconnect the old service are related together and there is no lapse in service between installation of the higher order of service and disconnection of the existing service, and
 - the service orders are for the same customer at the same location.

For the purposes of determining a higher order of service, the following ranking will be used (Analog=lowest, SMARTRing service=highest):

- SynchroNet Service
- MegaLink Service/MegaLink Channel Service/BellSouth Channelized Trunks¹ (T)
