### **A134.8 DataReach Service**

(Obsoleted 07-05-98, Type D - Not available to customers for new installations, additions to existing service, or transfers of existing service to new locations.)

#### **A134.8.1 Description of Service**

- A. DataReach service is an intraLATA service that provides a single number access to a data network provider's location.
- B. DataReach service will route calls based upon the wire center of the caller.
- C. (DELETED)
- D. The DataReach service subscriber will be billed for the transport of all DataReach service calls originating outside of the Basic Local Calling Area (BLCA) on a per minute basis.
- E. A DataReach service subscription is the routing information for one DataReach service number. A subscription to DataReach service is on a per LATA basis.

#### **A134.8.2 Terms and Conditions**

- A. DataReach service is available where facilities or arrangements permit.
- B. Limitations and use of service as stated in Section A2. will apply.
- C. (DELETED)
- D. Local measured or message rate service charges, if applicable, will be collected from end users, subscribing to measured or message rate service, for calls to a DataReach service number, as facilities permit. Local measured service subscribers will be charged the lowest rate band rate for any local call to the DataReach service number.
- E. DataReach service is deactivated by canceling a subscriber's DataReach service subscription.
- F. Calls to a disconnected DataReach service number will receive the vacant code announcement. The announcement provided will not refer the caller to another telephone number.
- G. Listings may be provided for DataReach service at rates, terms and conditions for a foreign listing as specified in Section A6. (T)
- H. A DataReach service number can be used for only one DataReach service subscriber.
- I. Suspension of Service as covered in Section A2. is not applicable for this service.
- J. In no event shall the Company be liable for any losses or damages of any kind resulting from the unavailability of its equipment or facilities or for any act, omission, or failure of performance by the Company, or its employees, or agents, in connection with this Guidebook. The Company shall not be responsible for calls that cannot be completed as a result of repair or maintenance difficulties on Company facilities and equipment nor on equipment owned or leased by the subscriber.
- K. The DataReach service subscriber shall subscribe to adequate exchange facilities to transport the calls to the subscriber location(s).
- L. For network sizing and protection, each DataReach service subscriber must provide an estimate of annual call volumes, the expected busy hour, and holding time for calls to the DataReach service number.
- M. The DataReach service subscriber must subscribe to the Customized Large User Bill (CLUB) and Regional Summary Bill (RSB) arrangement to facilitate administration of volume discounts for the service. This billing arrangement is not available in hardcopy format for DataReach service.

#### A134.8.3 Restrictions

- A. Calls to the DataReach service number cannot invoke the TouchStar service feature, Repeat Dialing, should they encounter a busy signal and want to keep trying the DataReach service number.
- B. A DataReach service number cannot be accessed by dialing an 800 or 900 Service number.
- C. 800 and 900 Service numbers cannot be used as Point-To Numbers for DataReach service.

#### A134.8.4 Limitations

- A. Callers served by a remote which homes on a switch located in another LATA cannot access DataReach service.
- B. Each of the DataReach service subscriber's Point-To Numbers must be located in a Company central office or in an Independent Company central office where that Company participates with *the Company's* AIN platform. (T)

#### A134.8.5 DataReach Service Report

- A. The DataReach service subscriber may subscribe to DataReach service Call Detail Information. This report provides monthly record, by DataReach service number, of terminating traffic to the subscriber. The Call Detail Information will include the calling telephone number, the DataReach service number, date, time of day, and call duration.
- B. DataReach service Call Detail Information may be offered where facilities permit and where the Company's message billing process has been arranged to provide this optional feature.
- C. Telephone numbers listed in the DataReach service Call Detail Information are intended solely for the use of the DataReach\* service subscriber. Resale of this information is prohibited by this *Guidebook*. (T)
- D. The DataReach service Call Detail Information will be provided on a diskette.
- E. The DataReach service Call Detail Information is not represented as provision of billing detail.

#### A134.8.6 Rates and Charges

- A. Application of Rates
  - 1. A Nonrecurring Charge and a Monthly Rate will apply for each DataReach service subscription.
  - 2. A per call charge will apply for each recorded call to the DataReach service number.
  - 3. A per minute of use charge will apply for each recorded call to the DataReach service number that originates outside the BLCA. All such calls will be billed a minimum of one (1) minute of use; calls greater than one (1) minute in duration will be billed in six (6) second increments. Optional Local Calling Plans will not apply.
  - 4. A volume discount may apply to the per minutes of use charge if the subscriber commits to a specific hours of use volume by signing a contract for a 12, 24, or 36-month period. The subscriber will be allowed a grace period of six (6) months on the 24-month contract and twelve (12) months on a 36-month contract to attain the committed hours of use per month. The grace period will apply only to the subscriber's first 24 or 36-month contract for the service. No grace period will be allowed on the 12-month contract.
  - 5. If the actual monthly hours of use is less than the contracted hours of use, the subscriber will be required to pay a minimum monthly settlement amount equal to the contracted rate for the monthly contracted hours of use. If the actual monthly hours of use is greater than the contracted hours of use, the subscriber will be required to pay the contracted rate for each minute of use.
  - 6. Volume Discount subscribers who terminate prior to the expiration of the contract will incur termination charges. Termination charges will be calculated by multiplying the minimum hours of use by the contracted per minutes rate times the number of months remaining in the contract. No penalty will be incurred by the subscriber for recasting during a contract period, if the contract is recast for an equal or greater contract period than that of the one terminated. If the contract is recast for a lower contract period than that of the one terminated, termination charges will apply for the terminated contract. If the grace period associated with the terminated contract has not expired, the remainder of the grace period will be forfeited. (M1)
  - 7. The Volume Discount will apply on a per subscriber basis. Actual hours of use will be accumulated for all DataReach service numbers assigned to the DataReach service subscriber. (M1)

#### **A134.8.6 Rates and Charges (Cont'd)**

##### **A. Application of Rates (Cont'd)**

8. A non-contract DataReach service subscriber will be billed a minimum of 20,000 hours of use per month. If the actual hours of use in a month is less than 20,000 hours, the subscriber will be billed for 20,000 hours of use. If the actual hours of use in a month is greater than 20,000 hours, the subscriber will be billed for the actual number of hours of use. No grace period will apply. (M)
9. The non-contract and 12-month contract DataReach service subscribers will be billed a minimum monthly settlement amount equal to the monthly minimum hours of use per month beginning with the first full month of usage if the actual usage is less than the monthly minimum hours of use.
10. A Nonrecurring Charge will apply to changes to an existing DataReach service.
11. Charges for Assignment of a 203-XXXX Number are applicable in addition to the charges for DataReach service.
12. DataReach service number changes required for Company reasons will not incur the Nonrecurring Charge.
13. Any charges for optional features associated with the Customized Large User Bill (CLUB) arrangement are applicable in addition to the charges for DataReach service.
14. A Nonrecurring Charge and a Monthly Rate will apply for each subscription to the DataReach service Call Detail Information.
15. Charges in Section A4. will not apply. (T)
