When at the determination of the Company maintenance of such equipment or facilities is to be charged for separately, the cost of such maintenance will not be included in monthly charges but will be based on costs incurred.

D. Conditions

1. Rates as specified herein include maintenance in accordance with the Company's standard practices, except when maintenance is charged for separately under Rates in Part 8, Section 5.1.C preceding.
2. When charges for services provided by the Company to meet specific customer requirements are not set forth above or referenced to charges in other Parts and Sections of this Guidebook, a charge based on costs, including capital costs will apply.
- ..3. Switching equipment and associated facilities furnished at Charges and Rates specified herein shall not exceed a maximum 5,000 station line capacity including switched stations located within the Nevada Test Site Toll Area and similarly switched stations located elsewhere, but served by the Private Branch Exchange System at the Nevada Test Site Toll Area.
4. The amount designated as basic termination charge reduces 1/120 for each full month the equipment is retained in service at the same premises.

In connection with the foregoing, upon partial disconnection of a system subject to a basic termination charge, the last equipment installed shall be considered to be the first equipment removed.

5. Key Telephone System Service

Key Telephone System service will be furnished in accordance with the conditions applicable to such service where furnished in an exchange, subject to the normal Company practices applicable at a toll station location:

- a. Installation charges for each line arranged for pickup, hold, or visual signaling provides for the termination of each line at existing stations of a system.
- b. Installation charges for single button and multi-button station arrangements provides for the termination of existing lines at the time stations or key units are installed

D. Conditions (Cont'd)

5. Key Telephone System Service - Continued

- d. Installation charges for cutoff and exclusion features apply to initial installations and to rearrangements.

6. Supplemental Equipment and Services

Supplemental equipment as designated herein, unless otherwise specified, will be furnished in accordance with the conditions applicable to such equipment where furnished in an exchange.

7. Optional Equipment - Cords

The nonrecurring charge for cords as covered in Part 8, Section 5.1.C.7 applies where replacement of the cord is required by the Company for proper maintenance of the equipment or service, or is requested by the customer.

- b. In connection with facilities for private line services and channels extending beyond the confines of the Intertoll District Areas.

The type of construction and the route of construction shall be determined by the Company and charges will be in accordance with the Company's established Guidebook and practices.

If at the request of the customer the Company constructs facilities of a type or over a route other than that which the Company would otherwise utilize, additional charges may be applicable.

8.5 SPECIAL GOVERNMENTAL SERVICES

8.5.1 NEVADA TEST SITE TOLL AREA (Cont'd)

D. Conditions (Cont'd)

8. Minimum Service Period

Except as otherwise specified, the minimum service period is one month.

9. Prorating of Charges

Charges for service normally furnished on a monthly basis, except those involving the minimum service period, billed for periods in excess of, or less than, a billing month, will be prorated on the basis of the proportionate amount of the monthly charge.

10. Liability of Company

The liability, if any, of the Company arising out of or in any way connected with any defect, error, omission, delay, mistake, interruption, suspension or other failure in connection with furnishing service or facilities shall in no event exceed the credit allowance set forth below:

No credit is allowed where the service or facility is "out of service" for less than a day. Where the service or facility is "out of service" for a day or more from the time it is reported by the customer or detected by the Company and is not due to the willfulness or negligence of the customer or the failure of any facility provided by the customer, credit is allowed for the proportionate amount of the monthly charge.

D. Conditions (Cont'd)

10. Liability of Company - Continued

A day of "out of service" will be considered to exist when service is not available for a period of twenty-four consecutive hours. When any "out of service" period continued for a period in excess of twenty-four hours or an even multiple of twenty-four hours, then the total period upon which to determine the credit allowance will be taken to the next higher even twenty-four hour multiple.

In no case will the credit allowance for any period exceed the total fixed charges for the service or facility for that period.

11. Provision of Access Roads, Commercial Power, Housing, Wiring and Conduit

Where commercial power is required in the operation of equipment and service, the customer shall furnish, install, and maintain the necessary power wiring and power outlets on his premises and supply any necessary electrical energy at his expense.

Where concealed telephone wiring is required on the customer's premises, the customer shall furnish, install, and maintain the necessary outlet boxes and conduit.

Any special structural work required for supporting telephone equipment or telephone wiring on the customer's premises shall be provided at the expense of the customer.

The customer will at his expense furnish and maintain suitable housing (including antenna supports) for Company equipment installed on the premises of the customer.

Road construction including maintenance and/or site leveling that may be necessary prior to the installation of telephone facilities shall be the responsibility of the customer.

8.5 SPECIAL GOVERNMENTAL SERVICES

8.5.1 NEVADA TEST SITE TOLL AREA (Cont'd)

D. Conditions (Cont'd)

12. Cancellation of Application

An application for service cancelled by the applicant or by the Company prior to the establishment of the service applied for is subject to the following conditions:

a. Cancelled by Applicant

- (1) If cancellation is requested by an applicant prior to the start of installation of facilities on the applicant's premises, no charge applies unless the Company has incurred an expense in which case a charge to the applicant equal to the estimated costs incurred in such installation, less estimated net salvage, shall be applicable.
- (2) If cancellation is requested by the applicant subsequent to the start of the installation of facilities on applicant's premises but before the facilities are connected for service, the application will be cancelled by the Company and the Company will collect all charges applicable to the facilities actually installed at the time of the requested cancellation.
- (3) If cancellation of an application for service is requested by the applicant subsequent to the time facilities are installed on applicant's premises and connected for service, such cancellation shall be treated as a regular discontinuance of service and the conditions of paragraph (2) above and the minimum requirements of the rate will be applicable.

b. Cancelled by the Company

If the applicant refuses to comply with the requirements set forth in the Company's Guidebook prior to the establishment of service, the Company may cancel the application, in which case any amounts collected from the applicant will be refunded.

8.5 SPECIAL GOVERNMENTAL SERVICES

8.5.1 NEVADA TEST SITE TOLL AREA (Cont'd)

D. Conditions (Cont'd)

13. Deferment of Service

At the request of the applicant, the in-service date for equipment furnished under provisions of the Company's Guidebook will be deferred subject to the following regulations:

- a. Where the installation of the service ordered has started but is not complete, a charge equal to the recurring monthly costs applicable to that portion of the completed installation will apply.
- b. When the installation is complete at the time of receipt of the request to defer the service, the regular installation and monthly charges will apply from the original requested in-service date.

14. Ownership and use of instrumentalities on Customer's Premises

- a. The Company shall own, furnish, and maintain all facilities including instrumentalities, protective apparatus, and other equipment necessary to provide telephone service, except as may be otherwise specified in the tariffs or guidebook. All facilities provided shall conform to the established construction standards of the Company. (N)
- b. All instrumentalities and equipment furnished by the Company in connection with a Customer's service shall be carefully used and only duly authorized employees of the Company shall be allowed to connect, disconnect, move, change, or alter in any manner, any or all such instrumentalities and equipment.
- c. The customer will be held responsible for loss of or damage to any equipment or apparatus furnished by the Company, unless such loss or damage is due to causes beyond the customer's control.
- d. No equipment, apparatus, circuit or device not furnished by the Company shall be attached to or connected with the facilities furnished by the Company, whether physically, by induction or otherwise, except as provided in this Guidebook. In case any such unauthorized attachment or connection is made, the Company shall have the right to remove or disconnect the same; or to suspend the service during the continuance of said attachment or connection; or to terminate the service.

D. Conditions (Cont'd)

15. Special Billing Number service provides for furnishing to the subscriber, each month, a separate listing of toll telephone messages charged to telephone numbers with either a 985 or 986 prefix. The minimum period for which the service is offered is two months.

16. Moves and Changes

A change of location from one premises to another will not be treated as a move, but as a disconnect and a new installation. The term "premises" refers to the space occupied by the customer in a single building or in connecting buildings.

17. Applicable in connection with Rates 7.t. above.

Charges and rates for FBX station lines under C. Rates 4.a. and key equipment arrangements under C. Rates 4.b. also apply in connection with the special key telephone station arrangements at the customer-owned and maintained console positions.

The basic termination charge reduces 1/120 each month the dial switching equipment and associated attendant's console are retained in service.

18. Definitions

Facilities in underground locations - includes that portion of facilities above ground, not exceeding 1,500 feet, to the point of connection with other distribution facilities.

Zone Charge - Charge to compensate in part for greater travel time than that normally incurred within an exchange area.
