#### C. OPTIONAL FEATURES AND FUNCTIONS

1. Central Office Multiplexing

#### DS-1 to Voice/Digital

An arrangement that converts a 1.544 Mbps channel to 24 channels for use with voice Grade, Digital Data Over Voice, or Digital Data Services.

#### D. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The minimum service period for DS1 Service is one month. DS1 Service circuits are offered month-to-month, on a one (1)<sup>3</sup>, two (2)<sup>2/2</sup>, three (3)<sup>2/2</sup> or five (5)<sup>1/1</sup> year term pricing plan (TPP), or under contract.
  - a. For customers that subscribe to a 1, 2<sup>(2)</sup>, 3<sup>(2)</sup> or 5<sup>(1)</sup> year term pricing plan, the monthly rates in effect at the time the service is installed may decrease but will not increase at any time during the term period.
  - b. Termination charges will apply to service terminated prior to the contracted period. The termination charge for all service terms will be calculated as follows:

For service terms that become effective on or after January 4, 2005:

- All unpaid Special Construction or Nonrecurring Charges (excluding any waived charges); plus
- Fifty percent (50%) of all recurring charges for the remaining months of the customer's

For service terms in effect prior to January 4, 2005:

- For the 1-, 2-<sup>12</sup> or 3-year<sup>12</sup> term pricing plan, the customer is liable for 100 percent of the monthly charges offset by one month's charges for each month of paid service.
- For the 5-year'<sup>1/</sup> term pricing plan, termination liability is the difference between the 3-year term pricing plan monthly rate times 36 and the actual number of months the plan has been in effect times the monthly rate for the 5-year term pricing plan.
- c. During the Term, the Customer may move one Channel Termination of a circuit to another location in the same LATA and keep the Term in force, provided no lapse in service occurs. Moves to a different Serving Wire Center may result in a change in monthly rates. Non-recurring charges, as appropriate, apply. If the Customer moves both ends of the service concurrently, the Customer will be liable for early termination charges.
- /1/ As of October 1, 2013, Term Pricing Plan terms greater than 36 months are no longer available for new or renewing subscribers.
- /2/ As of January 15, 2021, 24- and 36-Month Term Pricing Plans are no longer available for new or renewing subscribers.
- /3/ Effective August 29, 2025, customers may not elect a Term Payment Plan of any length, and existing Term Payment Plans of any length will not be renewed or extended. Upon expiration of any Term Payment Plan, month-to-month rates will apply subject to the Company's right to modify such rates upon notice to customer.
