Guidebook for Intrastate
Advanced Telecommunications Services
in Ohio

The Ohio Bell Telephone Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of AT&T Teleholdings, Inc. (also referred to herein as AT&T Midwest) and an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of AT&T Inc. AT&T Ohio is a registered trade name of The Ohio Bell Telephone Company. Services offered pursuant to this Guidebook may be offered under those registered trade names or under the brand name AT&T. All regulated services offered in this Guidebook by The Ohio Bell Telephone Company, whether under that name, the trade name AT&T Ohio, or under the brand name AT&T, are subject to the terms and conditions of this Guidebook (The Ohio Bell Telephone Company is also referred to herein as “the Company” or “Company”).

Effective September 30, 2011, PremierSERVsm Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) and PremierSERVsm Frame Relay services defined in this Guidebook will no longer be available to new customers. Existing term plan customers of PremierSERV Frame Relay Service and PremierSERV ATM Service may add, move, remove or change lines and/or locations for the duration of their current term plan agreement, but may not enter into any new term plan agreements except a new 12 month term for service additions as permitted above. The Company will support one extension of an existing non-expired term plan agreement (other than a new term plan for service additions as provided above) past its current term for twelve (12) months, provided the extension is signed on or before June 30, 2013 and the extension period expires no later than June 30, 2014. Upon expiration of the extension and for existing customers who do not extend an existing non-expired term plan agreement, service will continue on a month-to-month basis at the same rates in effect for such service immediately prior to such expiration, until the service is discontinued on at least 30 days prior notice by the customer or on at least 30 days notice (or such longer period as may be required by existing rules) by the Company. During such month-to-month period, the Company may change the rates, terms and conditions applicable to the customer’s service upon at least 30 days written notice to the customer. Effective September 30, 2011, early termination charges shall not apply to any PremierSERV Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) and PremierSERV Frame Relay services defined in this Tariff.

ADVANCED SERVICES**A. Application of Guidebook**

This Guidebook sets forth the service offerings, prices, terms and conditions applicable to the furnishing of service.

B. Services by Contract Only

Frame Relay and Asynchronous Transfer Service will be provided on an individual case basis (ICB) only.

Limitation of liability language in the contract does not constitute a determination by the PUCO that the limitation of liability imposed by the Company should be upheld in a court of law. Approval by the Commission merely recognizes that since it is a court's responsibility to adjudicate liability and consequent damage claims, it is also the court's responsibility to determine the validity of the exculpatory clause.

Services will be provided where facilities permit.

C. Force Majeure

The Company shall not be liable for any delay or failure of performance or equipment due to causes beyond its control, including but not limited to: acts of God, fire, flood, explosion or other catastrophes; any law, order, regulation, direction, action, or request of the United States Government, or of any other government, including state and local governments having or claiming jurisdiction over the Company, or of any department, agency, commission, bureau, corporation, or other instrumentality of any one or more of these federal, state, or local governments, or of any civil or military authority; national emergencies; insurrections; riots; wars; unavailability of rights-of-way or materials; or strikes, lock-outs, work stoppages, or other labor difficulties.

D. Services OfferedFrame Relay

The Company offers Frame Relay data services at speeds ranging from 56 kilobits per second (Kbps) up to 40 megabits per second (Mbps).

Asynchronous Transfer Mode

The Company offers Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) data services at speeds ranging from 1.5 Mbps up to 599 Mbps.
